

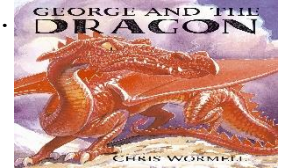


# Year 2 Newsletter

## English

For our English focus next week, we will be continuing our learning of the book 'George and the Dragon'. We will be orally rehearsing sentences describing the character George which will help us to write a character description of him by the end of the week. We will be using drama techniques such as 'hot-seating'. This will allow the children to think about how a character might be feeling.



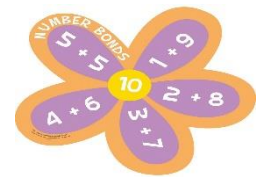
How to help at home:

## Maths

For our Maths focus next week, we will be recapping our knowledge and understanding of place value. We will be thinking about what each digit represents in a number. For example, how many tens are in the number 52? How many ones are there?

We will also be recapping number bonds to 10 and 20.



How to help at home:

Continue to practise memorising number bonds to 10 and 20. Practise playing number bond ping pong when walking to and from school.
