### How you can help at home:

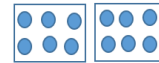
Look at different diaries e.g. food diaries, health diaries, academic diaries and compare differences.

## Maths

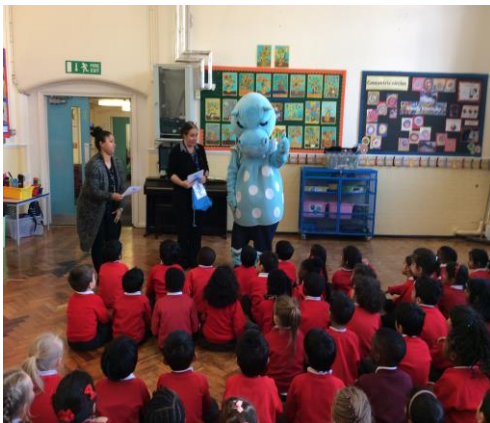
For our Maths focus next week, the children will be exploring division by sharing. They will be sharing numbers or objects equally between 2, 5 or 10 parts. Division is the opposite of multiplying. When we know a multiplication fact we can find a division fact. So  $6 \times 2 = 12$  and  $12 \div 2 = 6$ .

### How you can help at home:

$$12 \div 2 = 6$$



Use everyday objects and share them equally into different parts.
