At home help your child to make a Christmas list, a letter to Santa, or greetings cards to friends and family.



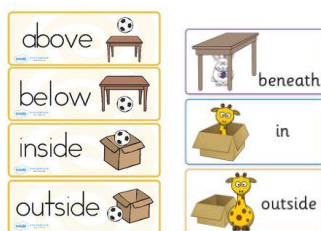
Communication and Language
