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## Expressive Art and Design - Toilet paper roll octopus craft

This toilet paper roll octopus is so easy to make and reduces waste.

First, you need

- Empty toilet paper roll
- Waterproof paint
- Paintbrush
- Googly eyes (optional)
- Scissors

How to make it

- Take your toilet paper roll and cut about 4 cm from the bottom of the roll. Do this all the way around until you have 8 tentacles.

- Bend each tentacle out so that the octopus can stand on its own.

- Paint your octopus. What colour do you want to paint it in? Add googly eyes if you have some or draw eyes with a black pen.

There you have it! A fun toilet paper roll octopus!


- Can you **think of a story** about the octopus? What will happen to her?




