Challenge: can you use, 'and' or, 'because' in some of your sentences?

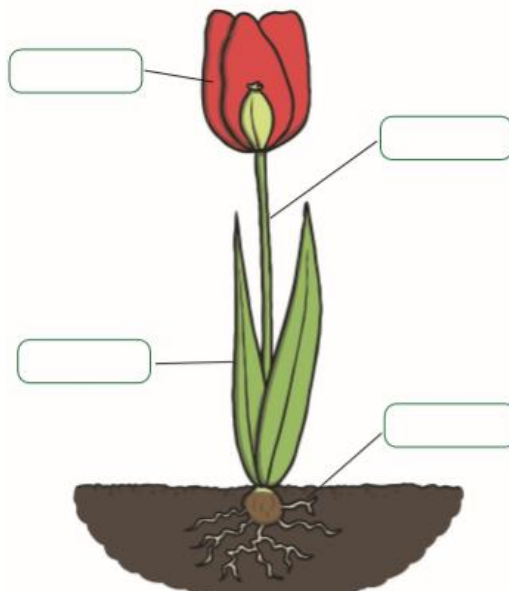
Example:
