Chase the Rainbow

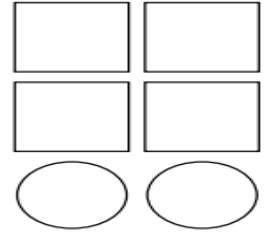


3. "Leave it in until it creeps up a little and then take it out (it will continue to grow)."
