Example:

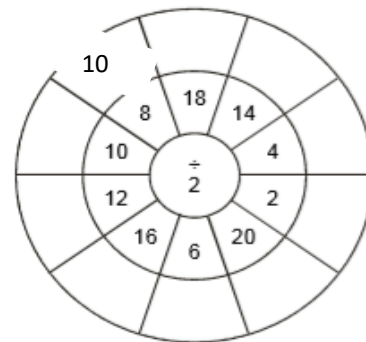
Winterbourne = win, wet, not
