- Cardboard (e.g. cereal box)

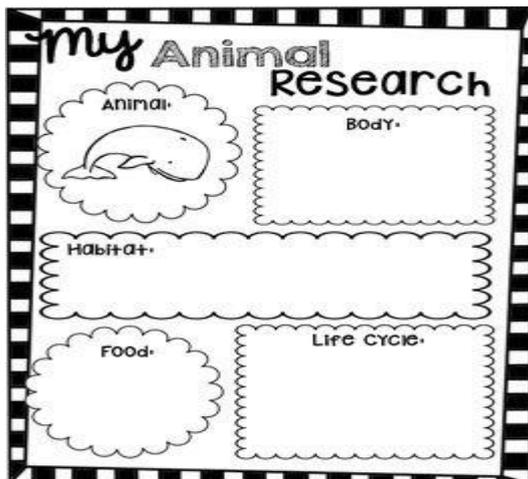
Draw your initials on the cardboard (use up as much of the cardboard as you can).
