

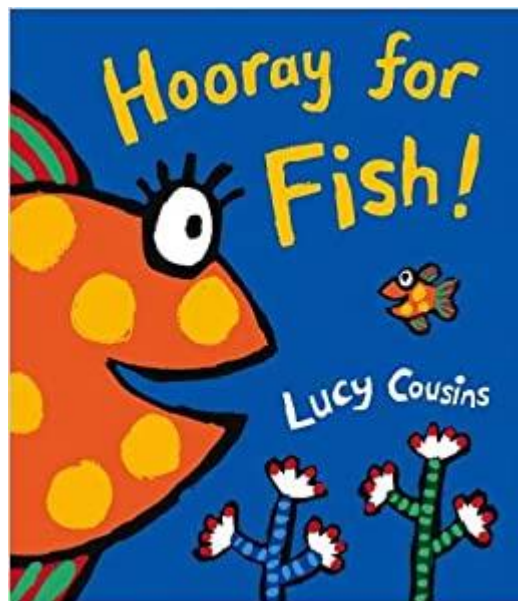

How about having a go at making some sandcastles of your own? This recipe for 'Moon Sand' is particularly good for making sandcastles!



Moon Sand

- 4 cups play sand
- 2 cups cornflour
- 1 cup water

Mix all the ingredients together. You should be able to squeeze the sand into a lump or make a sand castle. If the sand is too dry and crumbly, then add a tiny bit more water.

For a more exciting moon sand you could add the following ingredient,

- 2 tbsp coloured powder paint (why not divide your plain mix into two to make two colours?)

If you can't get hold of play sand, you can make wonderful sandcastles with flour as well!
