

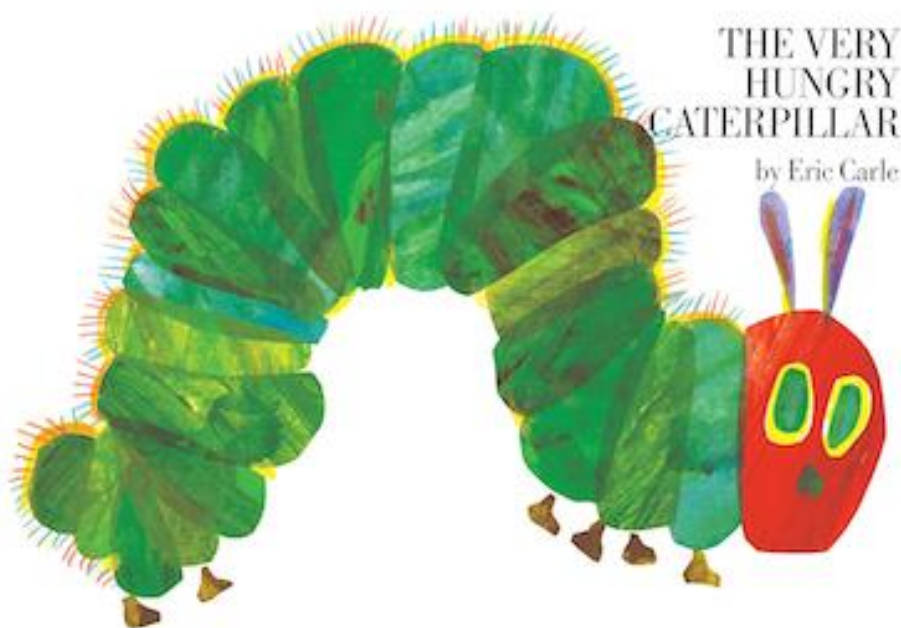

How about having a go at making some play dough caterpillars! Here is the recipe that we use, for homemade playdough. It lasts for ages.

2 cups of plain flour

2 cups of boiling water

Food colouring-few drops of your choice

1 cup of salt

2 desert spoons of cream of tartar

1 tablespoon of cooking oil

Method: place all dry ingredients in a bowl, add the water and oil and keep stirring!

Your children have been learning to roll the dough, either into balls or a snake.

You could find little pieces of twigs or stones, which they can stick in to the dough, to make eyes, a nose, legs etc.
