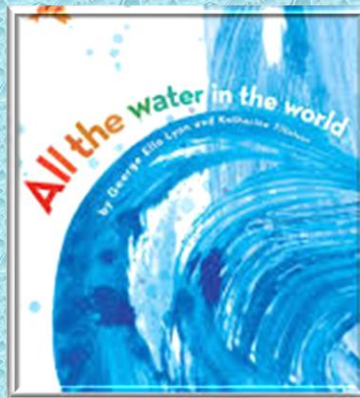

Can you mark make with your finger or a tool like a spoon, using a tray covered with some:

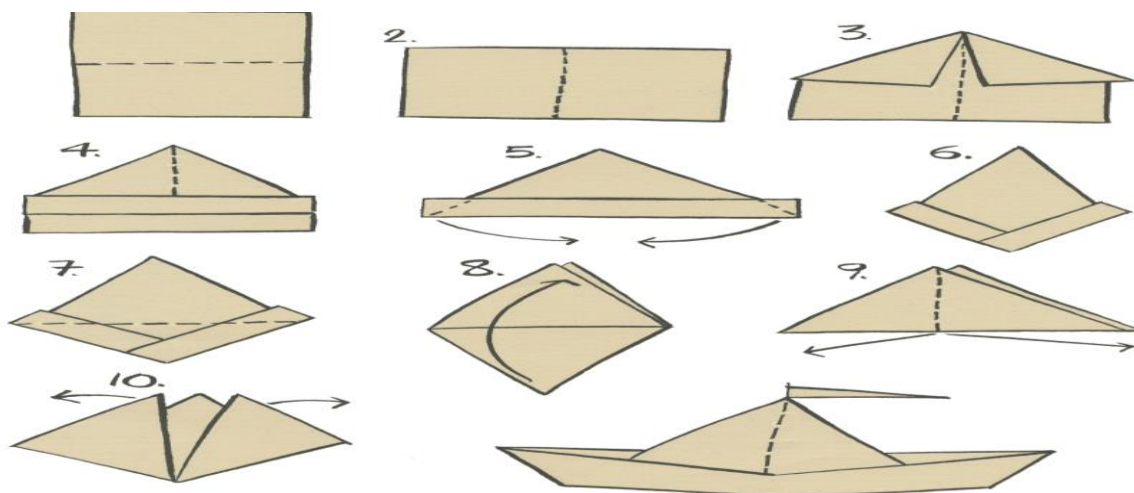
flour, sugar, custard, oats, or salt...
