
Literacy:

Fish and chips cookie recipe

Ingredients:

- 1 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup mini chocolate morsels
- 24 large chocolate morsels

How to make it:

Step 1

Beat butter at medium speed with an electric mixer until creamy; beat in powdered sugar until smooth. Stir in vanilla extract.

Step 2

Combine flour and salt in a medium bowl; beat into butter mixture. Stir in mini morsels. Flatten dough into a disk, wrap in plastic wrap, and chill 1 hour or until firm.

Step 3

Preheat oven to 350°. Line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper.

Step 4

Roll dough to 1/4-inch thickness on a lightly floured surface. Cut out shapes with a 4-inch fish-shaped cutter. Place on prepared baking sheets. Bake 8 to 10 minutes. Place large morsels on cookies to resemble fish eyes. Cool on pan 10 minutes, and transfer to wire racks to cool completely.
