Literacy –
Draw a picture of the weather that you can see outside your window and then think of 6 words to describe it.

You need to try and write the words using your sounds. Eg if I want to write the word 'hot' I need three fingers; pinch the sounds h-o-t then write the letters.

Carefully form the letters 'h – head to hooves and over the horse's back'

Phonics - See if you can read these words using your blending skills, remember 'say the sound ...read the word'
cat big den gum leg fish pot chap this red sing

remember to look for special friends (2 letters 1 sound)
sheep day night down foot moon start shout

Draw a picture to match this sentence:

It is a hot night, the moon is big and a red and brown fish can see it from the pond.

Maths – Can you remember how to do adding and taking away?

Use the numberline to help you count on or back to solve these number sentences.
