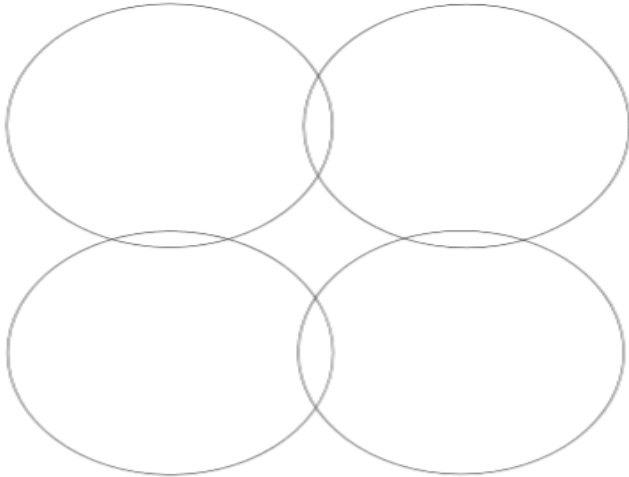

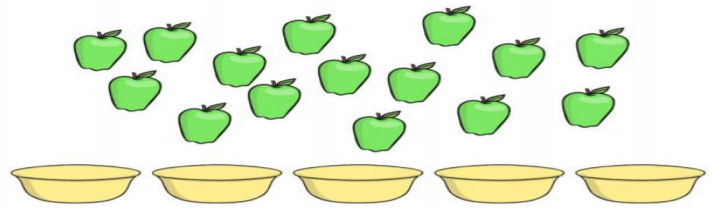

Look at the pictures. Divide the amount shown in each picture and record the division number sentence.

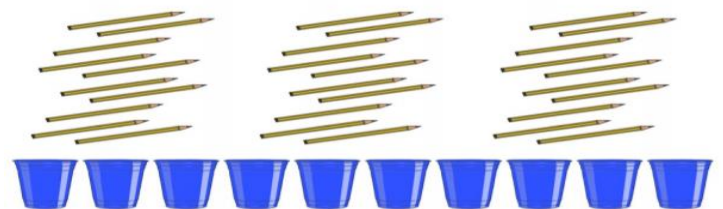
1. Divide the apples into 5 bowls.

Remember, there are two ways to divide; by sharing and by grouping.

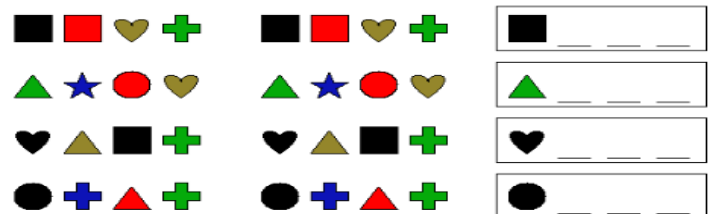
