Literacy –

I think we should all go on a picnic! Can you think of the food you would like to take?

Sandwiches, fruit, crisps, something to drink...



Make a shopping list so that we have lots of food to take for our day out.

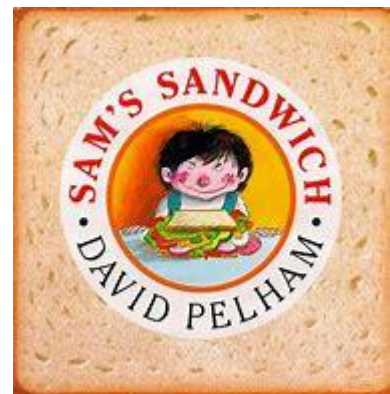
Use your sounds to spell the words.

How do you write 'crisps'? Say the word carefully out loud, then write

all the sounds you can hear.

Phonics – practise blending the sounds on these words – remember to look for 'special friends' then say the sounds and read the word.

Try this first one together...

ar ch (ar start the car) (ch-ch-choo) ar – ch ...arch

Now you try:

cat big much fish tray chick
deep might moon foot slow hang

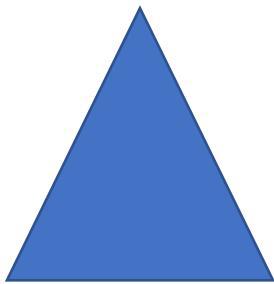
Choose 3 words to write each day – remember to form all the letters carefully.

Now think of food that is a triangle, rectangle or square shape!

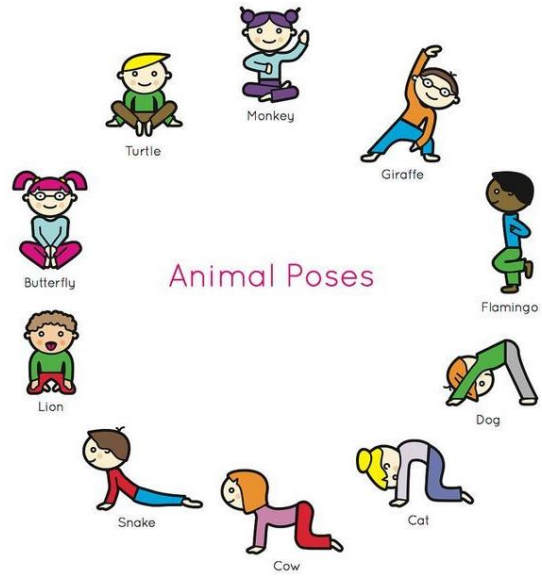


Physical Development –
