English

Next week in English we will begin looking at a brand new story book! We will find out more about it next week. With this story we will have a go at retelling it. We will also be recapping the punctuation and phonics we need to help us write captions and sentences. Later in the week we will write speech in speech bubbles to express what the characters are saying.

How you can help at home:

Write a few sentences about your first week back at school. Check that you have used the correct punctuation and phonics sounds.

Maths

Next week we will be exploring numbers up to 100. We will be finding one more and one less of numbers. We will also be recapping 'partitioning'. The children will be breaking up 2-digit numbers into tens and ones and thinking about the different ways that we can represent these numbers.

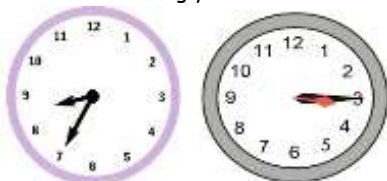
How you can help at home:

Practise counting up to 100 and backwards from 100. You could even make your own hundred square and fill it in. This will help to remind you how to form numbers the correct way and spot number patterns.
