If you are unsure if you fall in to the category of key worker, please read the updated key worker list on the school website.

If your child falls in to the vulnerable category you will be contacted on Monday as your child will be expected to attend school on the 5th January.

During this period all pupils will be expected to access the remote learning that is in place. Please see our remote learning policy on our school website.

If you are having difficulty accessing the remote learning, a paper copy will be available from Tuesday 5th January which can be collected from the school office. Please contact the school to arrange collection if needed.

Expectations of Remote learning:

- Teachers will post a timetable and links to daily learning under your child's year group on the Home learning link on the website
- Your child will be expected to complete the daily tasks set by their teacher.
- Work completed should be emailed to your child's year group email daily so that it can be checked by their teacher.
