Remote learning

This week in English, the children used their knowledge of non-chronological reports to plan and write their own information text all about domestic cats.

Next week, the children will be reading our new story 'The Tiger who came to tea' by Judith Kerr. They will explore the story using role-play and think of adjectives to describe the characters.

In maths this week, the children learned how to add by counting on and found number bonds to 10 and 20.

Next week in Maths, the children will be using skills taught in previous weeks to add by making 10 first. Throughout the week, they will use objects, pictures and a number line to do this.

In science this week, the children learned about the different foods animals eat. They sorted animals into the categories: carnivore, herbivore and omnivore. In next week's science lesson, the children will learn the differences between vertebrates and invertebrates.
