We enjoyed having some toast with different toppings and some juice for 'breakfast' in the nursery.



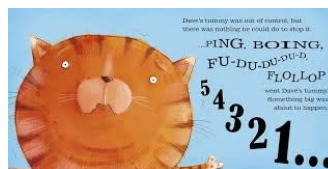
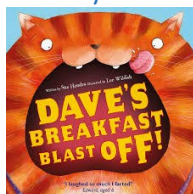
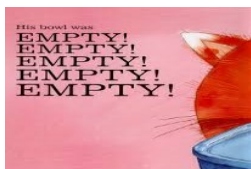
Can your child remember how they asked for help the use the toaster, or the knife?

inside, in front, behind.

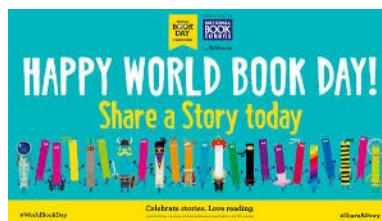


Parents Calls
