Remote learning

This week in English, the children created their own mini adventure based on the story 'The Tiger who came to tea' by Judith Kerr.

Next half term, the children will explore our new topic, the enchanted woodland, through the story 'Where the Wild Things Are' by Maurice Sendak. They will discuss and answer questions about the plot and think of adjectives to describe the characters.

In maths this week, the children learned how to subtract by taking away groups of tens and ones. They also learned how to subtract when crossing 10.

Next half term in Maths, the children will compare answers of both addition and subtraction number sentences. They will also explore word problems and use their previous knowledge to create number sentences independently.

In science this term, the children looked at and categorised animals. Next half term, the children will learn all about plants. They will identify and name common plants and describe the basic structure of a plant.

The word of the week after half term is:

Wander - walk or move in a leisurely or aimless way.
