English

The first day back will be full of fun activities, as an introduction to our new topic, 'Street Detectives'. One of the activities requires a small shoe/tissue box, so please make sure your child has one to complete the activity. We will begin reading the book Hodgeheg and learn about imperative verbs with instructional writing.

Maths

During the first week back after the half term, we will be recapping 2d shapes and their properties. Children will learn to sort out shapes using their knowledge of shape properties and will be learning to identify lines of symmetry on 2D shapes.
