### Literacy

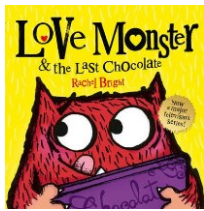
This week the focus text was :

number to the amount ...

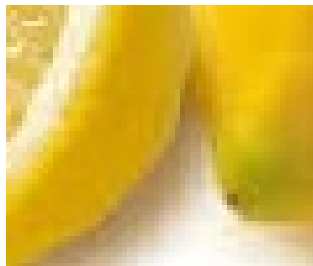
