Then discuss your child's favourite part of the story.

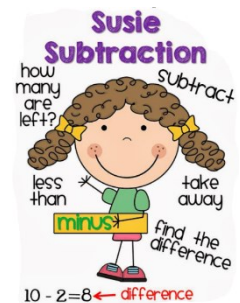


## Maths
