English

Next week in English we will be looking at time conjunctions. We will be ordering sentences using the time conjunctions to predict the sequence. We will also be looking at making words plural by adding 'es' and 's' as well as making words past tense by adding 'ed'. We will use these skills to write a postcard.

Write a sentence containing a word which has the past tense 'ed'.

Next week in Maths we are looking at counting in 2s and 5s. We will look at objects that have been grouped in 2s and 5s and use your counting skills to see how many there are. Then we will make multiples of 2 and 5 by creating our own groups.
