Literacy

Next week we will be reading the story of 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird' written by Eric Carle. We will have a go at writing a story ending and discuss how to treat others fairly. You can watch the story on the link below:

- Over the weekend if you can please let your child use the internet to find a few facts about: a stag beetle, whale and aphids which they will meet in the story.

Maths

In maths, we will be learning to count forwards and backwards, find 1 more and 1 less to 20.

You can help by counting a number of objects at home and ask your child to count on 1 more or 1 less.

Vocabulary: forwards, backwards, stag beetle, kind, bad-tempered, aphids, characters, fair, unfair, share.

Important messages:

To keep everyone safe we ask that all adults wear a face mask while on school premises. Thank you.

Please keep your child's reading book and yellow reading record in their school bag every day. Can you read the book with your child and write a comment in the reading record, please?

All children need water in a named bottle. Please ensure the lid is on tightly, otherwise water leaks and the book bags get soaking wet.

As the weather gets warmer please make sure jumpers have names written on the label, and train your child to fold their jumper and put it in their book-bag.
