How you can help at home:

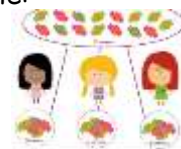
Try to share out the following numbers into equal groups:

Words of the week

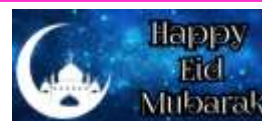
Fierce:
