Thank you for your support and the donation on World Refugee Day. We raised £214.95 which will be donated to Jesuit Refugee Services.

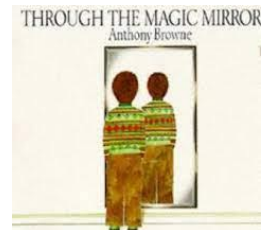


Please remember to bring the reading books and yellow reading records in your child's bag.
