We will be listening to the story 'Outside, Inside' by LeUyen Pham, discussing the story and the changes they have noticed happening inside and outside during different seasons.

Next week the children will consolidate their learning of alternative pronunciation of graphemes. Can they recall and write words with these sounds?

i (fin, find), o (hot, cold), c (cat, cent), g (got, giant), u (but, put (in south of England), ow (cow, blow), ie (tie, field), ea (eat, bread), er (farmer, her), a (hat, what), y (yes, by, very), ch (chin, school, chef), ou (out, shoulder, could, you)

They will practise spelling the tricky words: **said, so, have, like, some, come, were, there, when, out, made, came, one, make, here, do, what, please**

English: changes

Encourage your child to recite the alphabet and identify vowels in words.

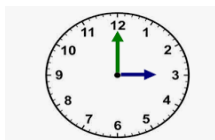


Continue to read for at least 15-20 minutes every day.
