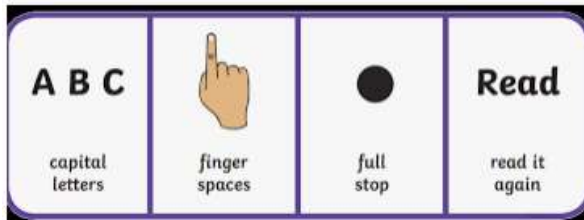

Literacy

Next week, the children will be writing a character description of Ruby, the main character of the story 'Ruby's Worry'. They will use the work they have done in previous sessions on nouns and adjectives to create their own character description. They will use their 4 senses to write sentences to describe what she looks like and her personality. The children will focus on using capital letters for the beginning of sentences and proper nouns (names) and full stops at the end of sentences as well as using finger spaces.



Things to do at home:

We have been learning about nouns and adjectives. What is a noun? Why do we use adjectives? Find out more about these parts of speech.

Maths

Next week, the children will be exploring the part-part whole model and partitioning numbers. They will be learning different number facts in fact families.

Count out up to objects around the house. How many different ways can you split (partition) them?
