



English

Speaking and listening objectives:

Listen attentively in a range of situations.

Write some irregular common words.

We follow the Little Wandle letters and sounds' programme.


We are recapping phases 3 and 4 then moving onto phase 5.

Finding number bonds to 10.







Reading

The children read with an adult x3 a week in a small group. In the groups they are taught to:

Identify diagraphs/trigraphs within words.

Read fluently.

The meaning of new unfamiliar words.

Answer questions using the text to help them.

Explain their answers.

Opportunities to review books


Read with expression taking into account of the punctuation.



Science

This term's Science topic is Animals Including Humans.

During this topic we will look at the human body. We will talk about the different parts of the body that we know and discuss



what they do.

We will also talk about the 5 senses.

This term's PSHE topic is all about who we are. The children will think about what makes them special. We will also think about our class community and the rights and responsibilities we have in class. We will also think about how our actions can have rewards as well as consequences.

Art

This term's Art topic is community.

During this topic we will look at patterns from different religions and countries and discuss what we like about them. We will try to recreate those patterns using printing techniques. Finally we will design and make our very own memory box decorated in the patterns we learnt about.



PE (Physical Education)

Children will continue to take part in a weekly PE session. Sessions will help to develop fundamental movement skills, become increasingly competent and confident and access a broad range of opportunities to extend their agility, balance and coordination, individually and as part of a team.

Children can come dressed in their PE kit on the day of their PE lesson.

Children will continue to take part in the 'Daily Mile'. This supports stamina and general exercise.

Computing

This term's Computing topic is all about internet safety.

We will discuss what personal information is and talk about how we can keep that information and ourselves safe when using an electronic device.



History

This term's History topic is changes within living memory.

During this topic we will think about the changes in our lives. We will talk about what has changed since we were a baby until now. October is Black History Month. We will find out about Martin Luther King, Rosa Parks and Serena Williams. We will discuss why they are important figures and talk about their impact on the world.



Music

This term in music they will learn about the untuned classroom percussion instruments - names of instruments, how to play them - tap/shake/scrape etc.

Use the percussion instruments to play basic 4 beat rhythms
