English

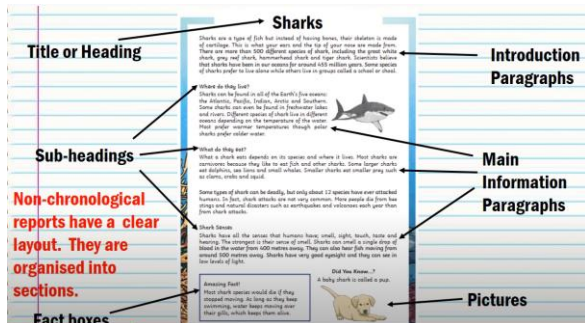
Next week in English, the children will be planning and writing their own Non-chronological report based on a Victorian school artefact of their choice.

They will include features such as: the heading, the sub-headings, factual sentences and an illustration (picture).

Things to do at home

For example: Sharks can be found in all 5 of the world's oceans.



Maths

Next week in Maths, the children will be subtracting tens and ones from 2 digit numbers. They will use tens frames and number lines to help them to solve subtraction number sentences.

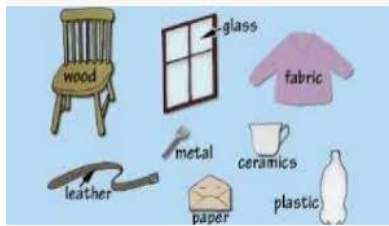
