

At Winterbourne Nursery & Infant School we will receive £18,810 sports grant for 2017-2018.

- We pay for a specialist sports coaching company to give pupils access to PE lessons taught by professionals with a high level of skill. This also allows for TA professional development, as the coach plans and delivers a session with the TA observing, they then team teach a session with the final plan being the TA delivering a session under the supervision of the coach; cost £6,420
- We used the funding this year to support our Sports week in June where the pupils had the to take part in a variety of sports – e.g. multi-activity day, zumba, hula hooping and cheerleading, at a total cost of £1,804
- £240 spent on a subscription for healthy eating/living
- £2,238 spent on providing additional sports equipment (games, gym mats, balance beams)

Approximately £8,000 will be carried over into academic year 2018-2019 to improve sporting facilities and equipment, coaching, and opportunities to try out different sports through enrichment and sports week.

What is the Impact of the Sports Premium Grant?

We would expect the impact to be:

- Increased opportunities for all of our pupils to access a wider variety of PE and Sports
- Opportunity to develop the competitive element of sports and the skills of sportsmanship
- Pupils are fitter, healthier and are motivated to continue to improve
- Improving health and fitness to have a positive effect on educational and behavioural standards

At Winterbourne Nursery & Infant School we will receive £18,590 sports grant for 2018-2019.

- We will pay for a specialist sports coaching company to give pupils access to PE lessons taught by professionals with a high level of skill and again providing professional PE development for our TAs; expected cost is £10,000
- We will use some of the funding to support our Sports week in June where the pupils will be given the opportunity to take part in a variety of sports; estimated cost £2,000
- To further promote healthy eating/living throughout the school; budget £750
- We aim to improve the outside environment/sports facilities as well as provide new equipment; budget (including carry-over) £13,750
