School Expectations

- All clothes named/labelled.
- Named water bottle filled with water only.
- School uniform to be worn and black shoes.
- No jewellery (studs only)
- Long hair tied up
- End of day collection (new person)
- Communication

Year 2 Expectations

- Dig deeper into what they learnt in Year 1
- Children will be encouraged to further develop their reading skills to enable them to become 'free readers'
- Teaching through cross-curricular topics
- New challenges (writing a non-fiction book, writing long narratives, numbers to 100, 2, 5 and 10 times tables, giving change, telling the time)
- Reading at home and at school

How you can help

Reading

- Children will change their books every week. We collect books on a Tuesday and send home books on a Thursday.
- Read with them daily.
- Ask them questions about the story e.g. What has happened? How does the character feel? How would you feel? What would you do?
- Encourage them to find the answer to the question in the text.

Spellings

- A list of common exception words will be sent home during the first week of term.
- They must learn how to spell these words correctly by the end of Year 2!
- Practise, practise, practise!

Maths

- Children will be sent home arithmetic papers on a Monday.
- Helps their mental maths.
- They will do the same paper in class on a Friday.

Homework

- Children will receive CGP books.
- The pages they must complete will be highlighted on the newsletter.
- Their homework will relate to what they have been learning in class that week.
- Make it an enjoyable experience.
