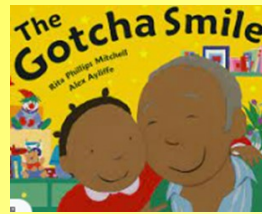

We are recapping phases 3 and 4 then moving onto phase 5.

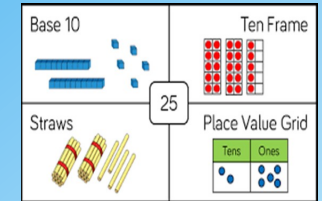
The children will learn the different letters that make one sound as well as the different sounds a group of letters can



Maths

In Maths this half term we will be focusing on numbers to 10 and place value. During this time we will be looking at:

- Sorting objects.
- Counting objects to 10.
- Counting and writing numbers to 10 both in numerals and words.
- Counting backwards from 10 to 0.
- Counting one more/ one less.
- Comparing groups.
- Comparing numbers of objects.
- Ordering objects and numbers.
- Using part whole models.
- Finding number bonds to 10.
- Adding numbers within 10.
- Children count reliably within 20.

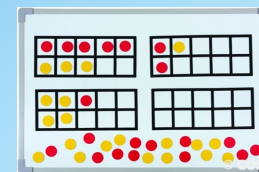

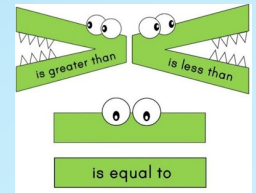
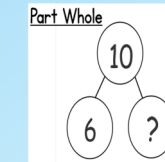
Using fingers

Reading

The children read with an adult x3 a week in a small group. In the groups they are taught to:

- Identify diagraphs/trigraphs within words.
- Read fluently.
- The meaning of new unfamiliar words.
- Answer questions using the text to help them.
- Explain their answers.
- Opportunities to review books
- Read with expression taking into account of the punctuation.

Additional Reading

Children will have one to one reading with an adult every two week and will be explicitly taught reading comprehension.

They will have daily story time and have a weekly reading assembly with Miss Buckley via zoom.

Science

This term's Science topic is 'Animals including Humans: The Human Body'.

During this topic the children will:

Name and identify parts of the human body.



Label the different parts of the human body.

Describe the function of each body parts.



PE (Physical Education)

Children will continue to take part in a weekly PE session. Sessions will help to develop fundamental movement skills, become increasingly competent and confident and access a broad range of opportunities to extend their agility, balance and coordination, individually and as part of a team.

Children can come dressed in their PE kit on the day of their PE lesson.

Children will continue to take part in the 'Daily Mile' and 'Brain Break' exercises. This supports stamina and general exercise.

History

This term's History topic is 'Changes within living memory'. During this topic we will think about the changes in our lives. We will talk about what has changed since we were a baby until now.

October is Black History Month. We will find out about famous chefs: Andi Oliver, William JM Chilila, Riaz Phillips and Shanice Bryce.

We will discuss why they are important figures and talk about their impact to our society.



PSHE

This term's PSHE topic is "Being me in my world"

This term's PSHE topic is all about who we are.

The children will think about what makes them special. We will also think about our class community and the rights and responsibilities we have in class.

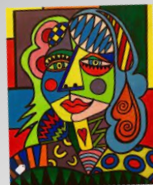

Art and Design
