Physical Development

Moving in a range of different ways (such as creeping or trotting)
Drawing lines and circles
Using one handed equipment and holding pencils correctly
Forming a few recognisable letters
Balancing, throwing, catching and kicking

Communication and Language

- Maintaining attention
- Responding to instructions
- Using language to imagine or extend play
- Introducing storyline or narrative into play.
