OUR PROVISION

Winterbourne Nursery and Infant School is a large infant school, we have Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 classes. We also have an Enhanced Learning Provision (ELP) for nursery age children.

We are extremely lucky to have a large outside space and a turfed area for the children to get fresh air and exercise. Nursery and Reception have their own outside areas, where their learning extends from the classroom. Years 1 and 2 have a large playground for break and lunch times. We also have a quiet space, with a story chair, perfect for sharing books. Our secret garden is an additional learning space, where our children take their learning outside, grow flowers and vegetables and observe nature at it's best!









ADMISSIONS

Nursery

If your child is already 3 years old, they can attend our nursery from September. If your child turns 3 years old between September and December, they can start nursery in January. If your child turns 3 years old between January and March, they can start nursery in April. Please contact the school office to get an application form and find out more.

Reception

Your child can start Reception in September 2024 if they were born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020.

Applications for a Reception place for September 2024 need to be made by 15th January 2024 to the Local Authority, via Croydon E-Admissions.

Every child in Reception to Year 2 will receive a free school meal every day. This is a hot, cooked, nutritionally balanced meal that is delivered to us by our caterers and eaten in a pleasant dining experience. Every child is given a drink of water with their lunch. OUR UNIQUE APPROACH

At Winterbowrne Nursery and Infant school, we pride owrselves on ow creativity and fun approach to learning. We encourage the children to be excited about all subjects, starting each new learning journey with a 'WOW day!'. This hooks the children in, to be excited about what learning is going to happen.

We host various curriculum days and weeks throughout the year, such as Number Day, International day, Refugee week, Art week, Science week, Neurodiversity Celebration week and World book day to name but a few.

We have our resident HERO bear to encourage consistently good attendance and Phonics bear to make Phonics even more exciting!









OUR WIDER CURRICULUM

At Winterbowrne Nursery and Infant School, we offer various clubs. We believe that offering this wider cwriculum for the Winterbourne child, develops them into being a more rounded person when they leave us at the end of Year 2. We have a resident Sports' Coach who teaches the children PE and runs many of the clubs.

BREAKEAST CLUB

Breakfast Club runs Monday to Friday from 7.45am until yowr child starts school at either 8.35am or 8.45am. Breakfast Club is just £2 per day and includes a nutritional breakfast for your child.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

After School clubs run Monday to Thursday, until 4.30pm for years 1 and 2. There are a number of clubs to choose from, including football, multi-skills sports, tennis, bikeability and dance. All clubs have a fee, however, if you are eligible for Pupil Premium funding, clubs are free. Please contact the school office for a Pupil Premium eligibility form.. You will receive a letter informing you of the fees of the various clubs.



WE ARE AN INCLUSIVE SCHOOL

At Winterbourne Nursery and Infant School, we are proud to have a diverse community that reflects many backgrounds, beliefs and religions. We want all of our children to be proud of who they are and where they come from.

Meeting the needs of every child is at the heart of what we do. All teachers plan the learning for their classes based on the needs of the children. Learning is set according to where your child is at, ensuring they make good progress throughout the year.



SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS AND DISABILITIES (SEND)

All children learn differently; at different rates and in different ways. We are all individual! We are proud not to label our children and to instead recognise the individual strengths of every child. Some children learn differently and will need some support with this, however, it does not change who they are.

As a key value, honesty plays a huge part in supporting your child. Honest and open conversations between parents and staff are designed to ensure we meet the individual needs of the child and enable them to have the support they so require.

Should you have any concerns about your child's learning, please talk to your child's class teacher in the first instance. The class teacher will then liaise with the SENDCo or Assistant SENDCo.

Our policy for SEND is based on the SEND Code of Practice. This policy can be viewed on our website, as well as accessing many resources to support you and your child.

SAFEGUARDING

Keeping our children safe is most important to us. We work closely with other agencies involved in Safeguarding and Child Protection. We have a duty of care to report any welfare concerns about the children in our school.

OUR SCHOOL UNIFORM

Wearing a school uniform creates a sense of pride and belonging. Our children are a part of our school community and being proud of who they are within our school is important.
