

## English

We will be reading the stories:

### Character Descriptions:

The children will be making predictions and learning about nouns, adjectives and character descriptions.



### SPAG:

They will continue to work on capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. They will be introduced to suffixes *s* and *es*. For example dog –dogs or wish—wishes.

Key vocabulary: describe, character, character description, appearance, actions, behaviour

### Phonics

We follow the Little Wandle letters and sounds' programme.

We are learning **phase 5 sounds**.

The children will learn the different letters that make one sound as well as the different sounds a group of letters can make.



### Additional Reading

Children will have one to one reading with an adult every two week and will be explicitly taught reading comprehension.

They will have daily story time and have a weekly reading assembly with Miss Buckley via zoom.

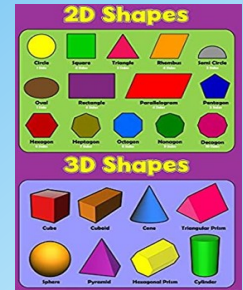
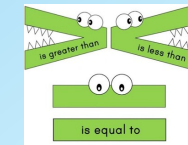
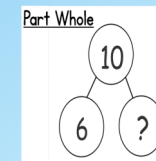
## Maths

In Maths this half term we will be focusing on **place value, addition and subtraction within 20**. We will also focus on **2D & 3D shapes**. During this time we will be looking at:

- Number and place value within 20.
- Counting forwards and backwards within 20
- Finding one more and one less within 20
- Comparing amounts within 20
- Addition and subtraction within 20
- Part – whole within 20
- Number bonds within 20
- Partitioning tens and ones within 20

Geometry – properties of 2D & 3D shapes

## Reading

The children read with and adult x3 a week in a small group. In the groups they are taught to:

- Identify diagraphs/trigraphs within words.
- Read fluently.
- The meaning of new unfamiliar words.
- Answer questions using the text to help them.
- Explain their answers.
- Opportunities to review books
- Read with expression taking into account of the punctuation marks.

## Science

This half term's Science topic is **Materials**.



During this topic the children will:

- Identify and name different materials— wood, metal, fabric, plastic and glass
- Sort and classify materials
- Describe the properties of materials—hard, soft, shiny, bendy, etc

## PE (Physical Education)

This half term the children will learn skills in – **Throwing and Catching**

- Controlled form
- Knowing positions

Children will learn how to:

- To show good levels of hand eye coordination when throwing/ catching.
- To have an understanding of different muscles in use when balancing different ways.
- To be able to show different types of movement.

## History

This half term's topic is **Significant People/ Real Life Superheroes**.

During this topic we will learn about significant people and find out what they did to make things better for others and discuss why they are real-life superheroes, this will further develop their understanding of Chronology (timeline)/ We will have special visitors that will discuss their jobs/ roles and how they help the community.



## PSHE

This half term's PSHE topic is **Celebrating Differences**

The children will identify similarities and differences- accepting that everyone is different and unique. They will discuss how to make friends and solve problems amongst friends.

We will also think about our actions and how they can affect others- being kind.

## Music

This half term the focus is **Superhero Music**.

The children will learn-

- To use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.

## Design & Technology (DT)

This half term's DT topic is **Superfoods**

This topic will explore different foods and identify which foods are good for us- 'superfoods'. They will discuss and refer to prior knowledge in Reception, where they learnt about healthy food. They will create a nutritional snack for a superhero. The children will have a superhero picnic exploring and tasting nutritional healthy snacks.



## Computing

The topic in Computing this half term is – **Online safety**

The children will learn about what the internet is and how it can be used, recognise that the internet may affect mood or emotions, recognise how internet use can affect and upset others and identify which information is appropriate to share and post online and

## RE (Religious Education)

This half term's R.E topic is **Christianity**.

We will explore the word 'Christianity' and discover its meaning. We will discuss what Christians believe about God and why prayer might be important to them. We will have a church visit this half term so children can see their place of worship.
