



Statements are sentences that give you a fact, opinion or idea.

I cried a lot today. They end with a full stop.

They usually contain a verb.


Partner 1 tell your partner a statement.



LQ: Can I understand what statements, questions and Tuesday 27th February 2024 commands are ? Questions are sentences that ask you something. They usually end with a question mark.

Can we go to the park? This requires an answer It will finish with a question mark.

Partner 2 ask your partner a question.



They can end with a full stop or exclamation mark depending on the tone of the sentence.

Commands are often urgent or angry, they can be short and contain an imperative verb (bossy verb).

An exclamation is used when someone is surprised.

What a spectacular trip!

It will start with 'how' or 'what'. It can sound like a question but it isn't as it does not need an answer. It will end in an exclamation mark






