

### Street Detectives





We use this topic to support teaching in all areas of the curriculum.


In this topic the children will be exploring:


- The maps of our local area, Thornton Heath and city, London (Geography).

- Creating their names using graffiti, street art (Art).



### <u>English</u>

We will be writing their own recount as a diary entry about their trip to London.

The children will be learning the features of a diary such as writing the first person, using time conjunctions, chronological order and expressing emotions,.

They will then publish their work from their teacher's feedback and self-editing to produce their final diary entry.

This term we will be following 'No nonsense spelling' and learning new strategies to spell more High frequency and Common exception words.

Our reading focus is using the text to find the answer to questions.



### **Phonics**


We follow the Little Wandle Letters and Sounds' programme. We are learning phase 5 sounds.

The children will continue learn the different letters that make one sound as well as the different sounds a group of letters can make.




### <u>Maths</u>


Fractions, 2 D shapes, 3D shapes and their properties.




We will be leaning how to recognise, find, name and write fractions 1/3, 1/4, 2/4, 3/4 of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity, understanding that all parts must be equal.



The children will identify and describe the properties of 2D shapes, including the number of sides, vertices and lines of symmetry.



Also the properties of 3Dshapes, including faces, edges & vertices to compare and sort common 2D and 3D shapes.



### <u>Science</u>

Animals Including Humans

We will be exploring the life stages of animals and humans.

The children will be researching and describing how offspring grow into mature animal. Also children are going to find out and understand the basic needs for survival.






### Geography

Map Skills

During this topic the children will draw and make a simple sketch map and talk about it. We will learn positional and directional language. They will be using google maps of the school area to navigate to our local park.
















# Thornton Heath Explore and investigate

- What makes a book special?





### Physical Education (PE)

Children will continue to take part in a weekly PE session. This term the children will learn invasion games.

## Computing


We are going to learn about algorithms, how to follow it.

We follow Kapow Program








# Personal, Social, Health Education (PSHE)

## Reading


The children reads with and adult x3 a week in a small group. In the groups they are taught to:

- Identify diagraphs/trigraphs within words.
- Read fluently.
- The meaning of new unfamiliar words.
- Answer questions using the text to help them.
- Explain their answers.
- Opportunities to review books
- Read with expression taking into account of the punctuation.





## The importance of reading regularly

Reading for pleasure









- Children will change their books every week. We collect books on a Tuesday and send home books on a Thursday.
- Read with them daily.
- Ask them questions about the story e.g. What has happened? How does the character feel? How would you feel? What would you do?
- Encourage them to find the answer to the question in the text.

## Friday Morning Reading

We are inviting parents and carers to come into their child's classroom and read from 8.35 – 9am every Friday morning.

This will be time to speak with their teachers about reading strategies such as:


- Support to help with decoding.

- Talking about the text using open questions.










### **Maths**

- On a Monday children will practicing methods solve arithmetic paper as a class.
- They will discuss which methods they find easiest and how they found their answers.
- The children will then sit the same arithmetic paper on a Friday independently.
- This paper will be sent home on a Friday and their teacher will record their score.
- Helps their mental maths.
