
English

We will be focusing on: Diary Entry/Recount

We will be writing our own recount as a diary entry about our trip to London.

The children will be learning the features of a diary such as writing the first person, using time conjunctions, chronological order and expressing emotions, . They will then publish their work from their teacher's feedback and self-editing to produce their final diary entry.



No Nonsense Spelling This term we will continue to follow 'No nonsense spelling' and learn new strategies to spell more High frequency and common exception words.

Our reading focus is using the text to find the answer to questions.

Maths

Fractions, Statistics, Geometry and Measurement

We will be leaning how to **recognise**, find, name and write fractions 1/3, 14, 2/4, ¾ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity, understanding that all parts must be equal.

The children will identify and describe the **properties of 2D shapes**, including the number of sides, vertices and lines of symmetry. Also the **properties of 3D shapes**, including faces, edges & vertices to compare and sort common 2D and 3D shapes.

We will be leaning how to recognise, find, name and write frac-

tions 1/3, 1/4, 2/4, ¾ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity, understanding that all parts must be equal.



Reading

The children read with and adult x3 a week in a small group. In the groups they are taught to:

Identify diagraphs/trigraphs within words. Read fluently.

The meaning of new unfamiliar words. Answer questions using the text to help them.

Explain their answers.

Opportunities to review books

Read with expression taking into account of the punctuation.



Science

Animals Including Humans

We will be exploring the life stages of animals and humans.

The children will be researching and describing how offspring grow into mature animal. Also children are go-

ing to find out and understand the basic needs for survival.

The children will be learning about lettering, collaging and using mixed media. At the end of the half term they will create their own names.


PE (Physical Education)

Computing

We are going to learn about algorithms, how to follow it.

Geography – Map Skills



We will be using our detective skills to explore and discuss about our local area -Thornton Heath and our city.

During this topic the children will draw and make a simple sketch map and talk about it. We will learn positional and directional language. They will be using google maps of the school area to navigate to our local park.

<u>Music</u>

Children have a specialist teacher who will teach the child how notations and beats.

They will listen 'Boléro' which is a 1928 work for large orchestra by French composer Maurice Ravel. This piece has been called Ravel's most famous composition.

In R.E the children will learn the about specials books.

At the end of this term Children will know that religions have special books that help them learn about God. Children will be able to identify the different Holy Books and
