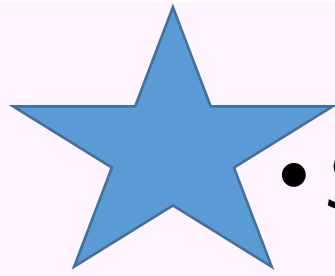
Steps to Success

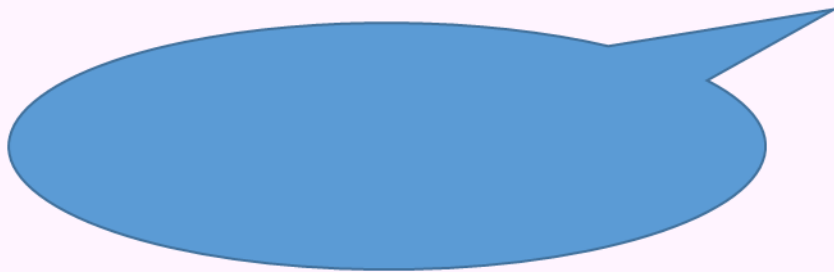

TP: Why people have different beliefs?

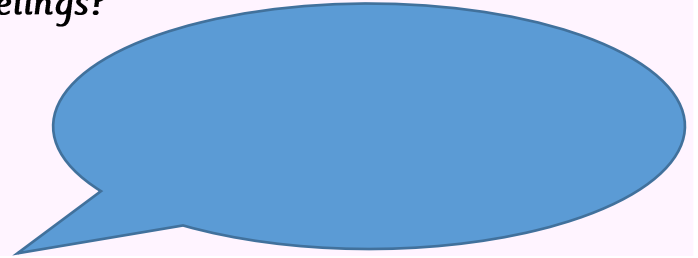
- The world is a big place made up of lots of different countries and people.

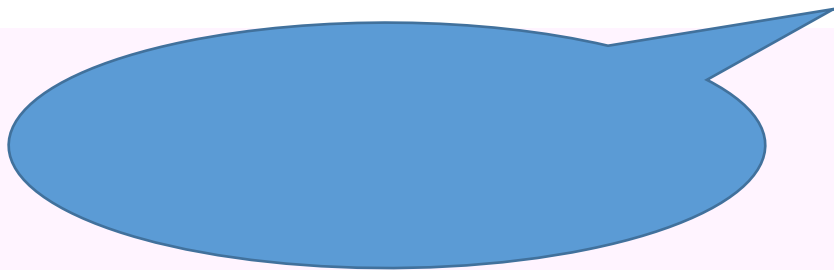
