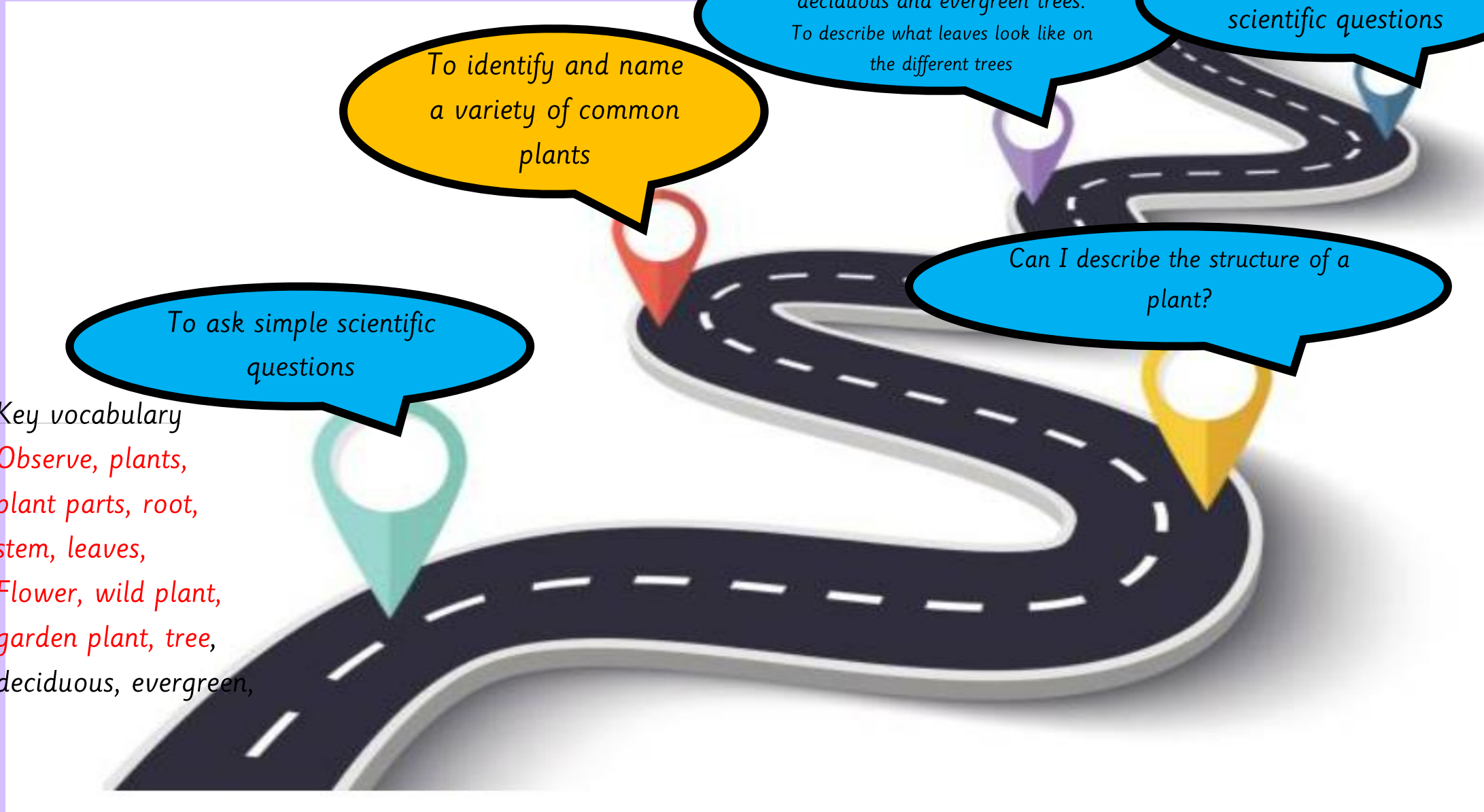

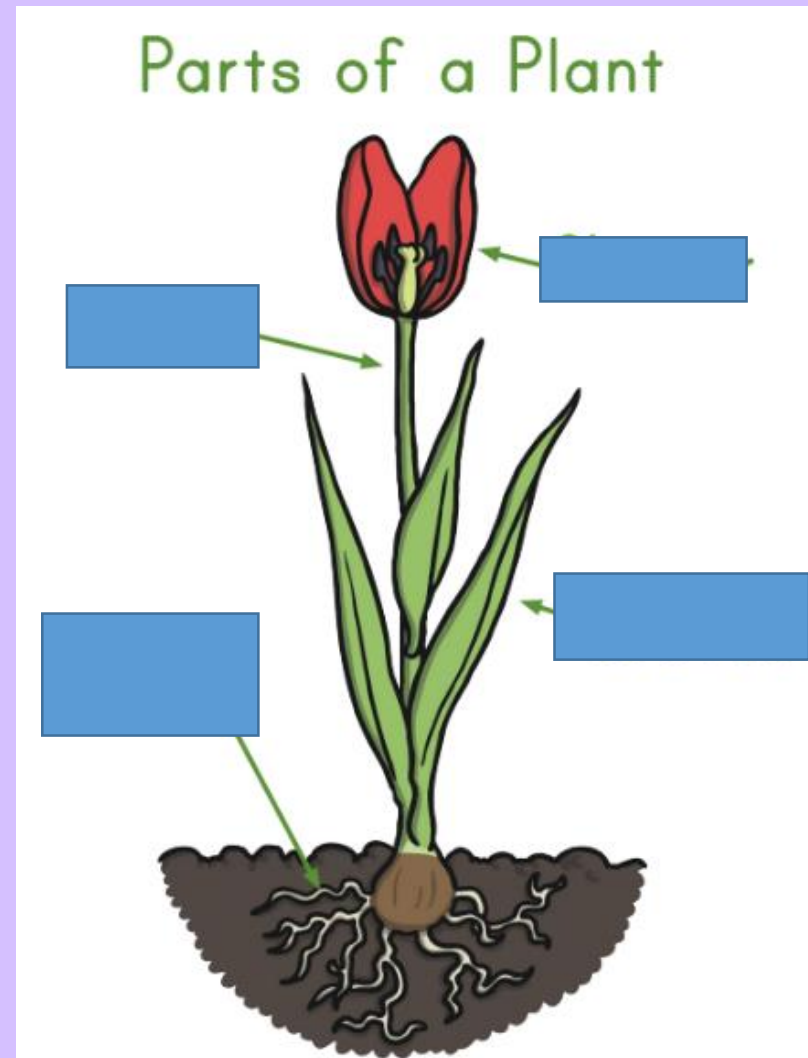
*This half term we will be observing different types of plants. We will be observing how they differ from winter to spring, we will also identify and classify a range of plants.*

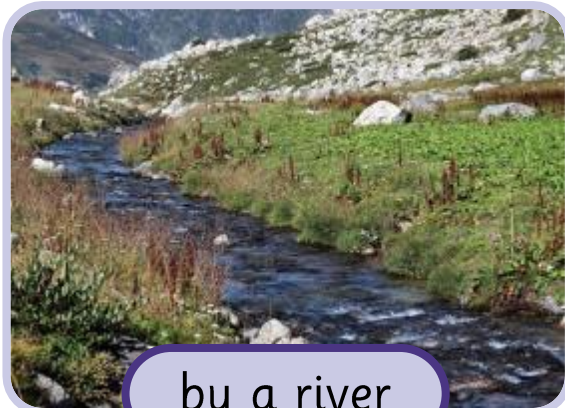

## Where Do Plants Grow?

Plants that are grown in places like gardens and parks are called **garden plants**. These are usually planted and looked after by people.

# Where Do Plants Grow?

Some plants grow wherever their seeds fall. We call these **wild plants**. They are not planted by people.



We call them **weeds**.

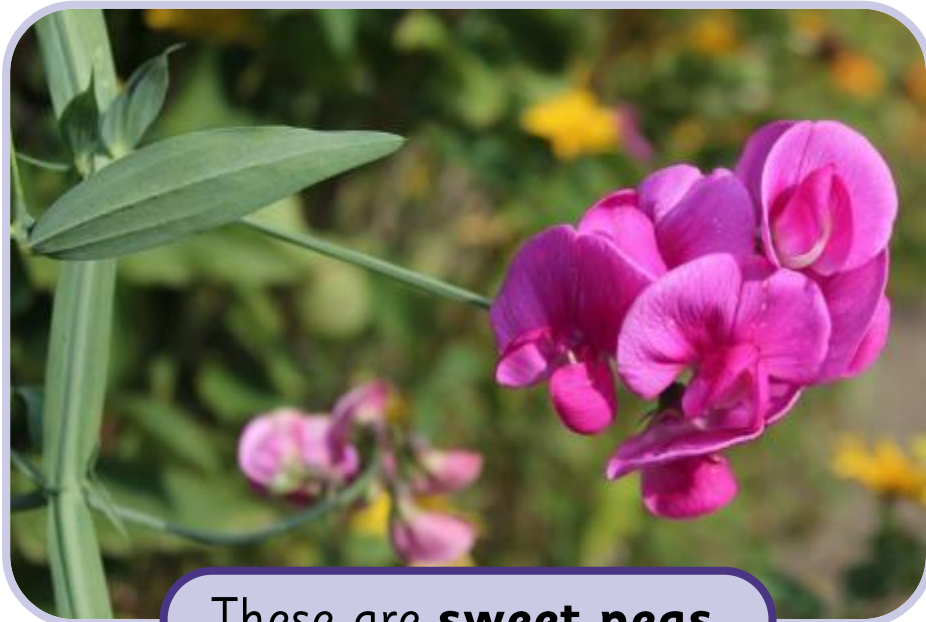

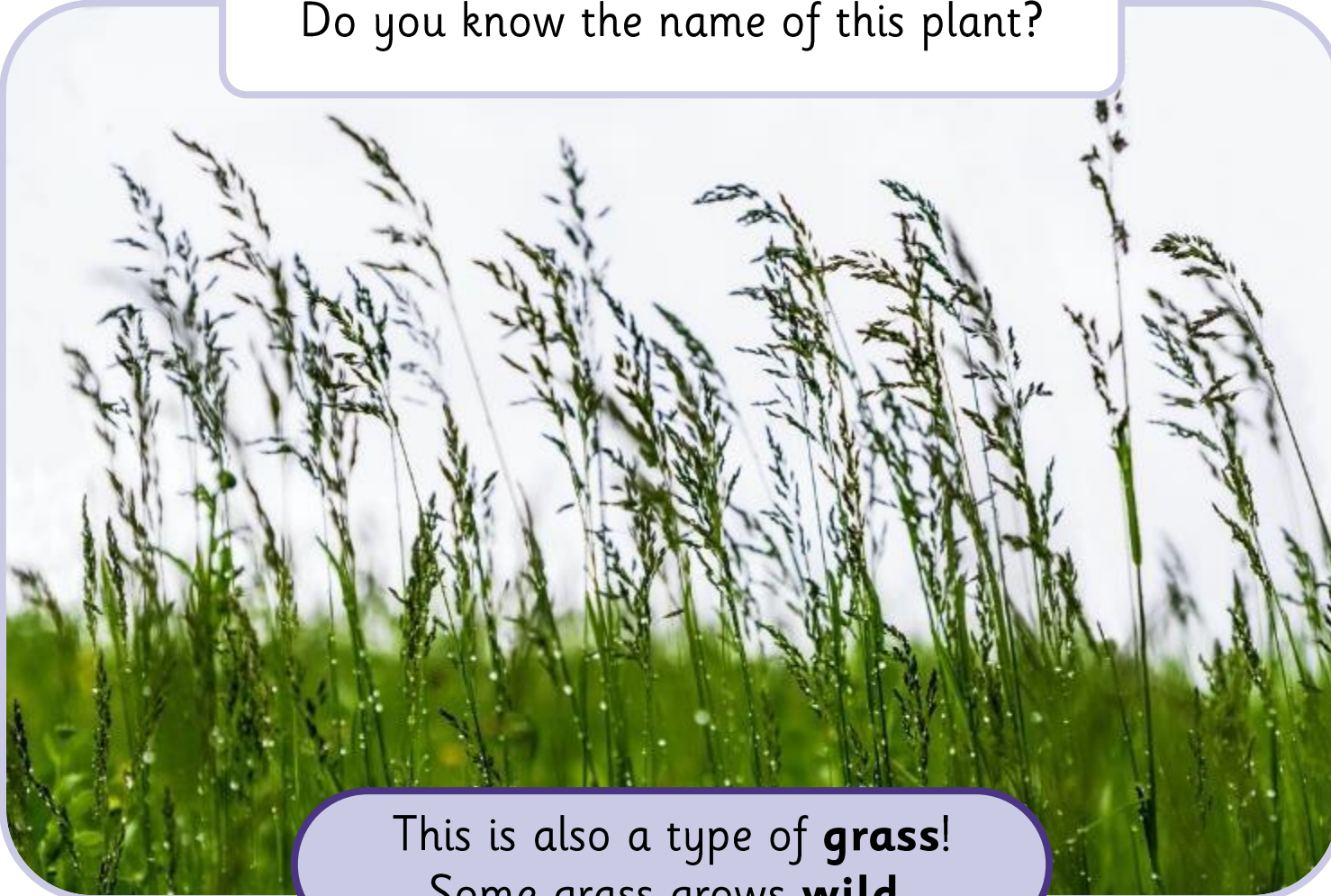


Grass can be either a **garden plant** or a **wild plant!**

These are **dandelions**.

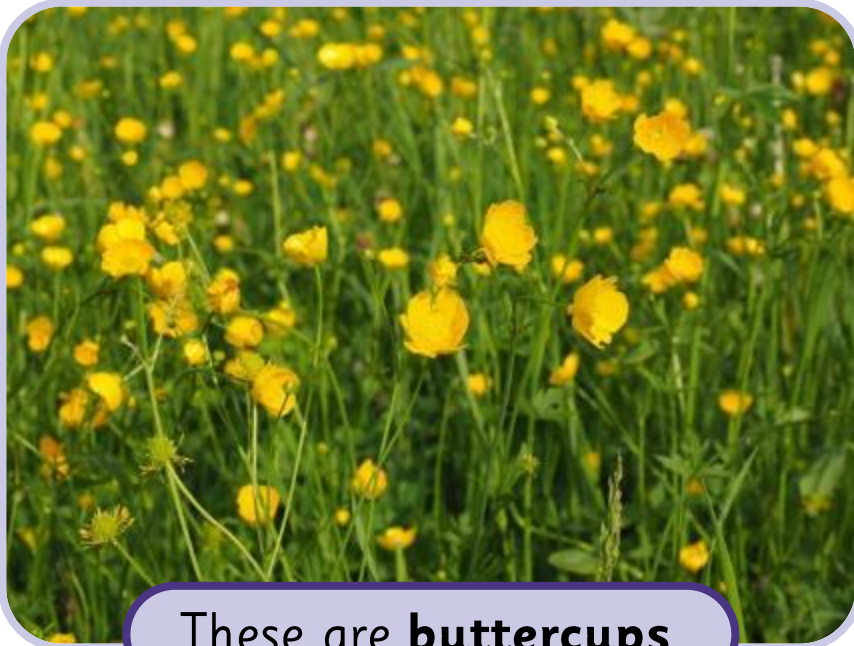


These are **daisies**.

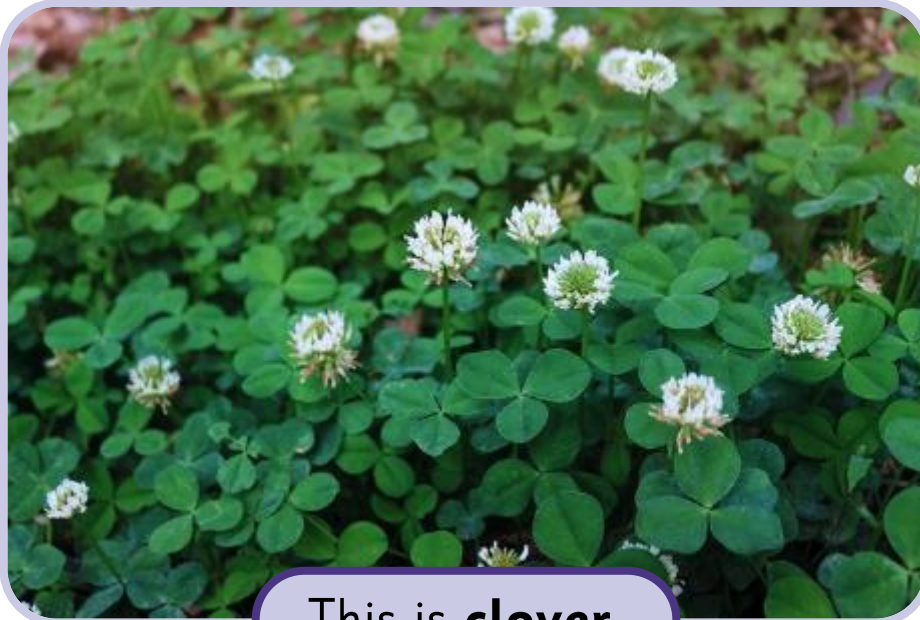
