

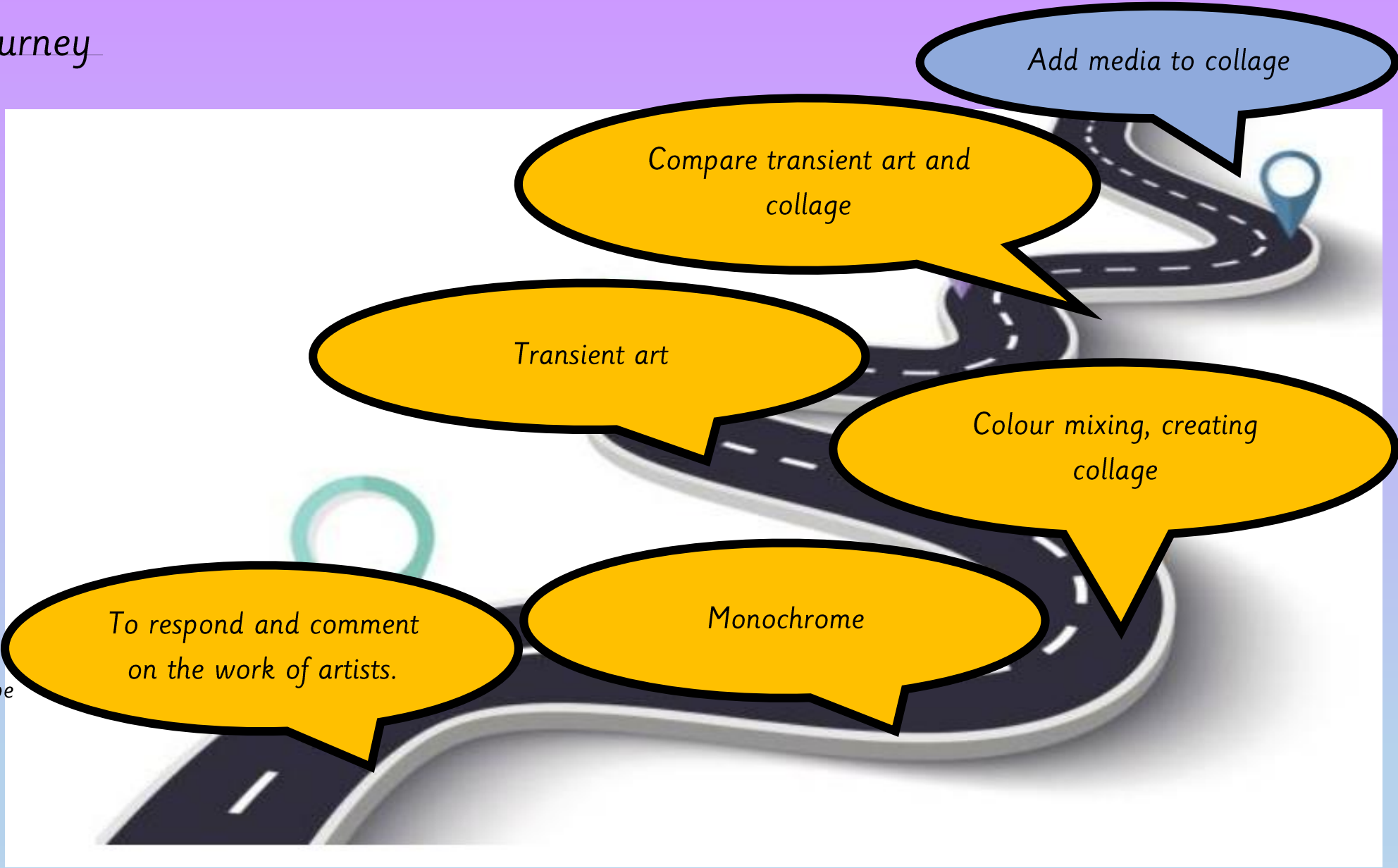

What is transient art?

Transient art is the use of **loose parts** or **natural material** to make art that is '**moveable**' and not permanent. Transient art can be changed overtime and continuously developed.
