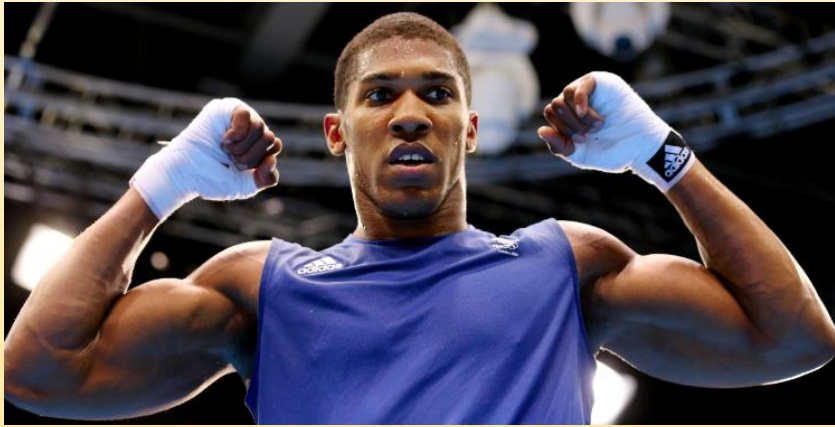

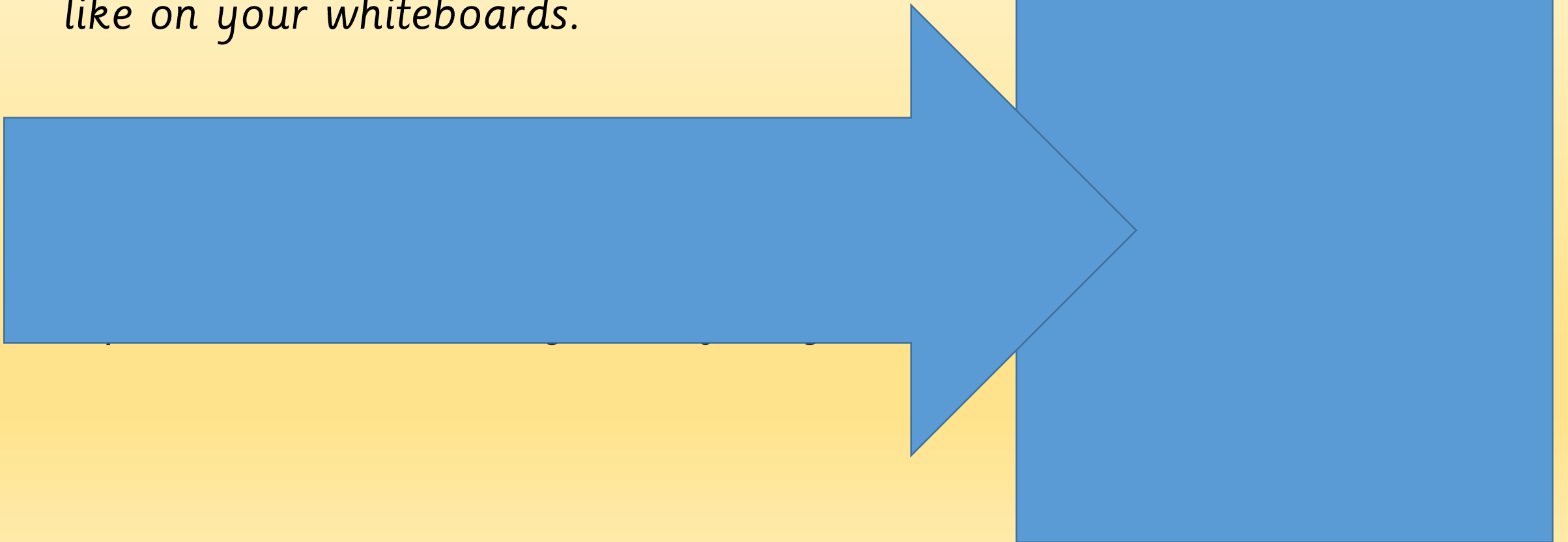

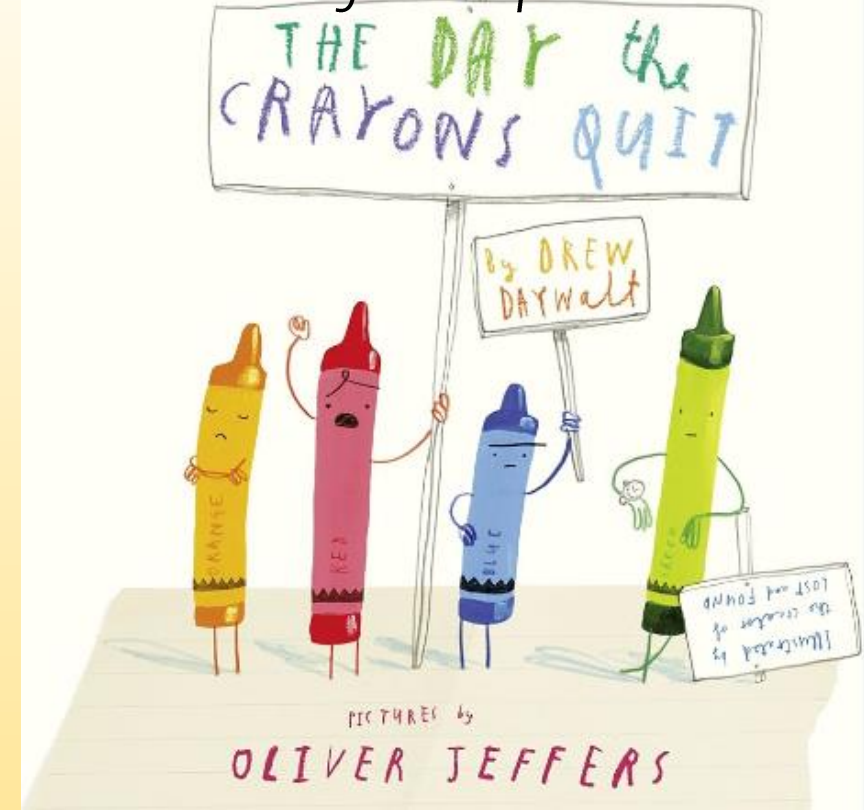
Task 1

Invite the children to explore powder paint in its dry state then adding water until it can be painted with and splattered/ flicked.



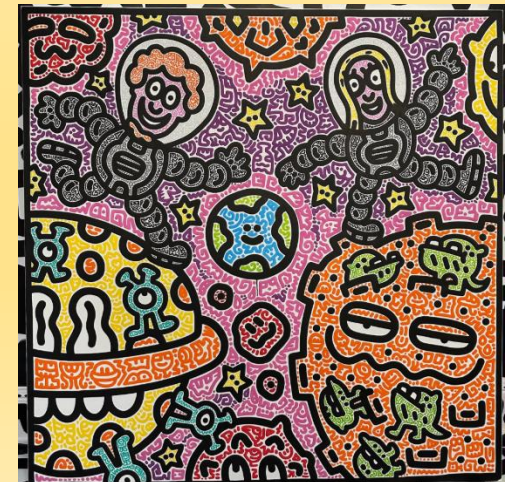

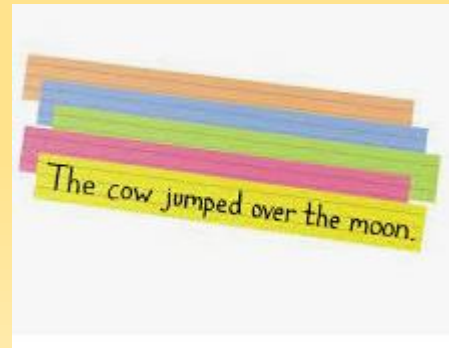

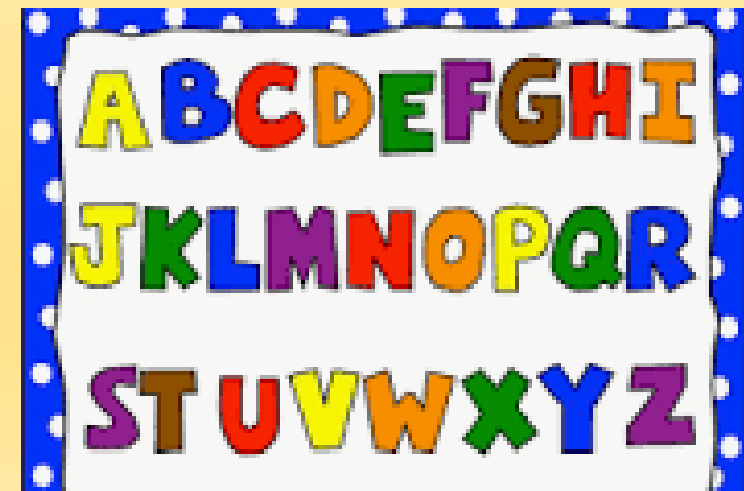

Capital Letters

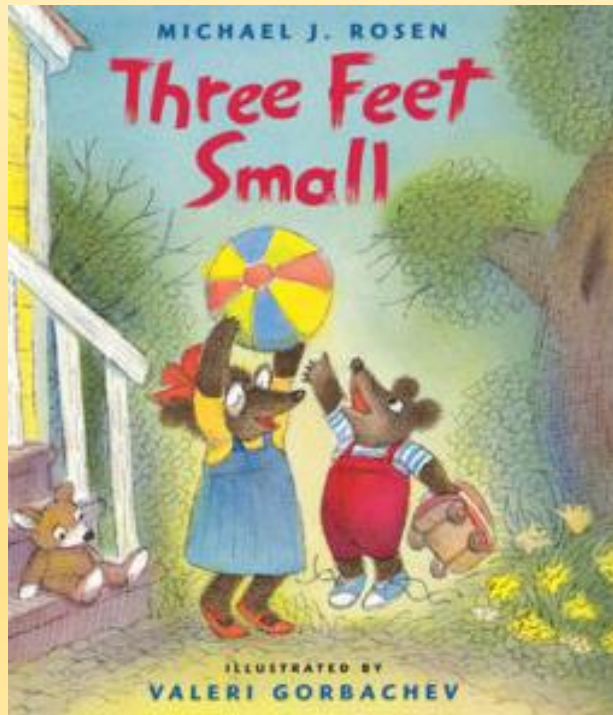


New sentences always start with a capital letter.

What is a pronoun?

A pronoun is a word used in place of a noun to avoid repetition and make sentences flow better.

When do we use them?

Pronouns can refer to people, places, things, or ideas. Common examples include "he," "she," "it," "they," "we," "you," "me," "him," "her," "us," and "them".

He is jumping on her trampoline.



The pronoun 'I' must always be a capital letter.

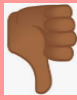

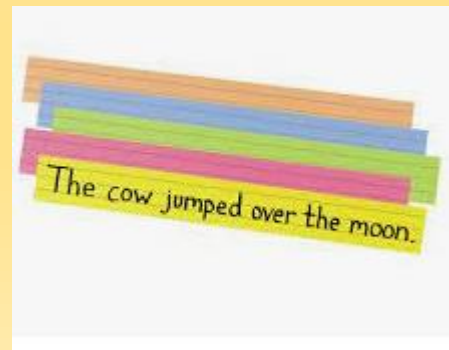
