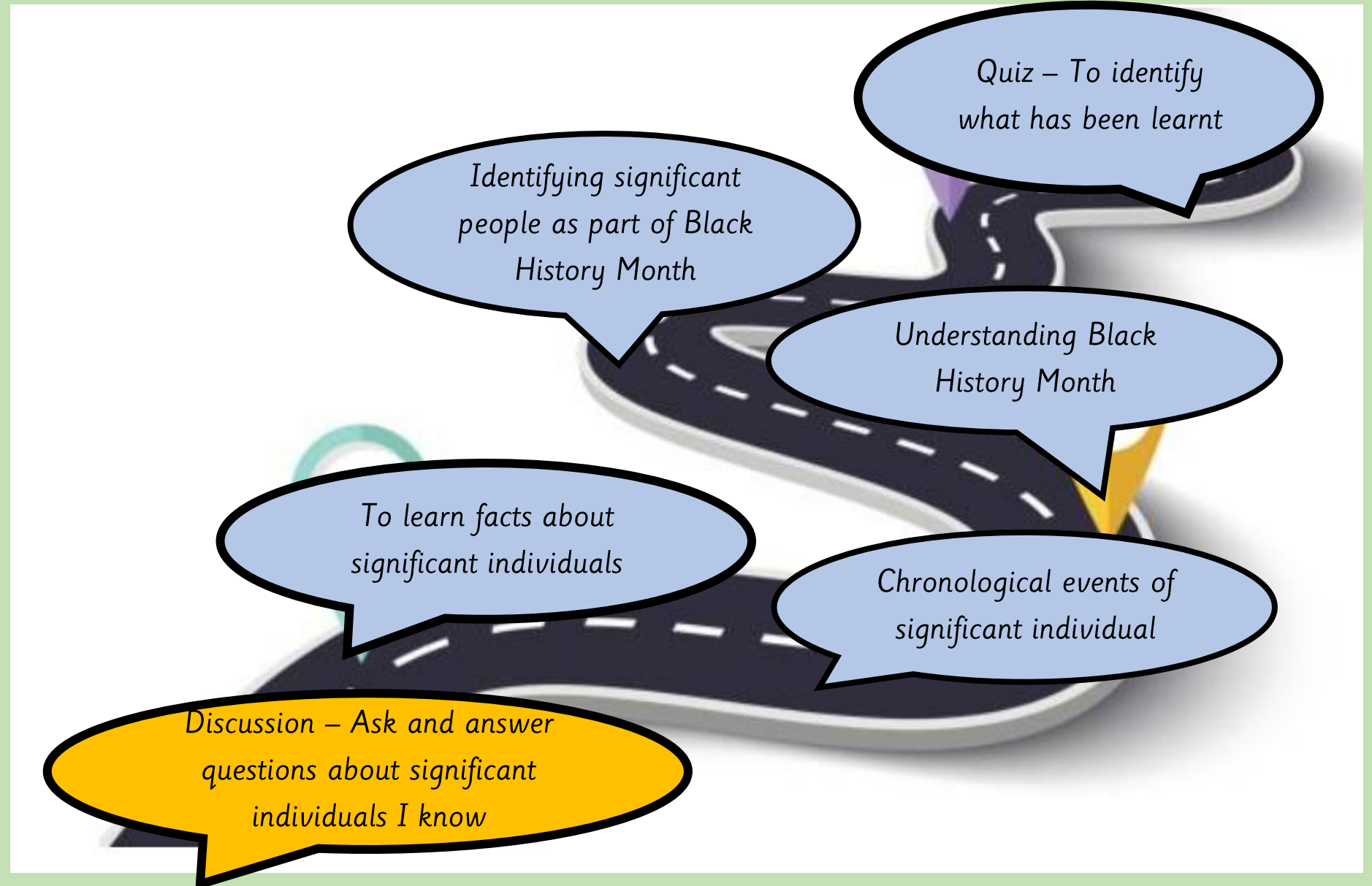

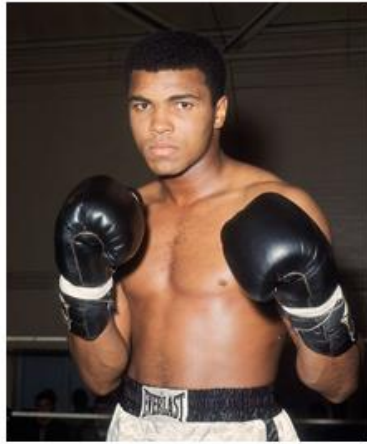

Serena Williams is an American tennis player who has won 23 Grand Slam singles competitions. This is more than anyone has ever won since these types of tennis competitions started.



Usain Bolt is a Jamaican athlete and the fastest sprinter of all time.

Usain won a gold medal in both the 100m and the 200m in three Olympic Games - 2008, 2012 and 2016. He was the first athlete ever to do this.



Mo Farah has run for Great Britain in many big athletics competitions. He is thought to be one of the most successful British athletes of all time.

He won a gold medal in the 5000 metres and 10,000 metres in both the 2012 and 2016 Olympic Games.



Marcus Rashford is a famous footballer. He played for Manchester United and England. In 2020, a virus called COVID-19 changed the way we lived. Lots of children had to stop going to school and had to do their learning at home. This meant that children who had free school meals might be hungry if their families didn't have much money to buy food.

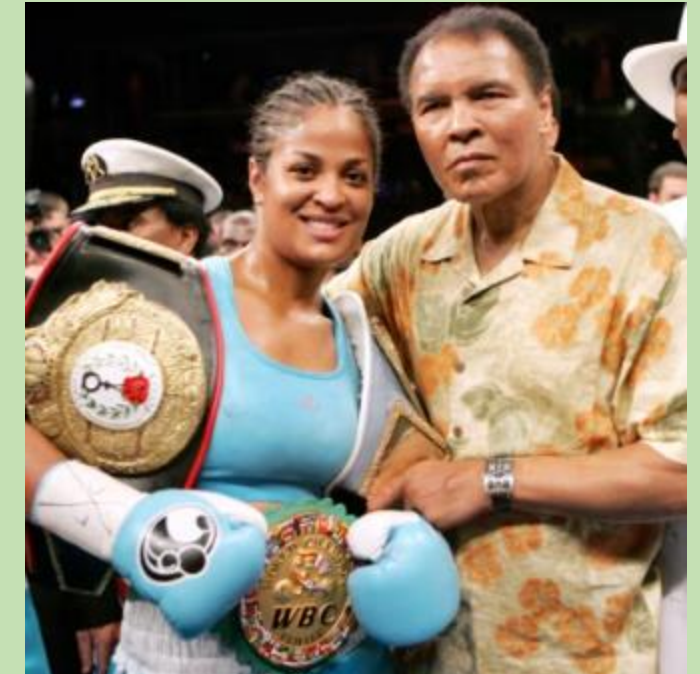

Muhammad Ali was an American Olympic and professional world-class boxer. He was also an activist and involved in the 1960s Civil Rights Movement in America. He is regarded as one of the greatest sportsmen of all time, and the BBC named him the Sportsman of the Century in 1999.

Denise Lewis is a retired athlete who won an Olympic gold medal in Sydney in 2000. Denise competed in the heptathlon. The heptathlon is an outdoor sport made up of seven events. These events are the 100 metre hurdles, the high jump, the shot-put, the 200 metres, the long jump, the javelin throw and the 800 metres. After retiring from athletics, Denise became a commentator for lots of athletics events.

Sir Lewis Hamilton is one of the most successful Formula 1 drivers of all time, winning seven World Championship titles.

In 2008, he became the first Black driver to win the Formula 1 World Drivers' Championship and, in 2020, he was knighted by Queen Elizabeth II for his outstanding achievements and contributions to motorsports.
