

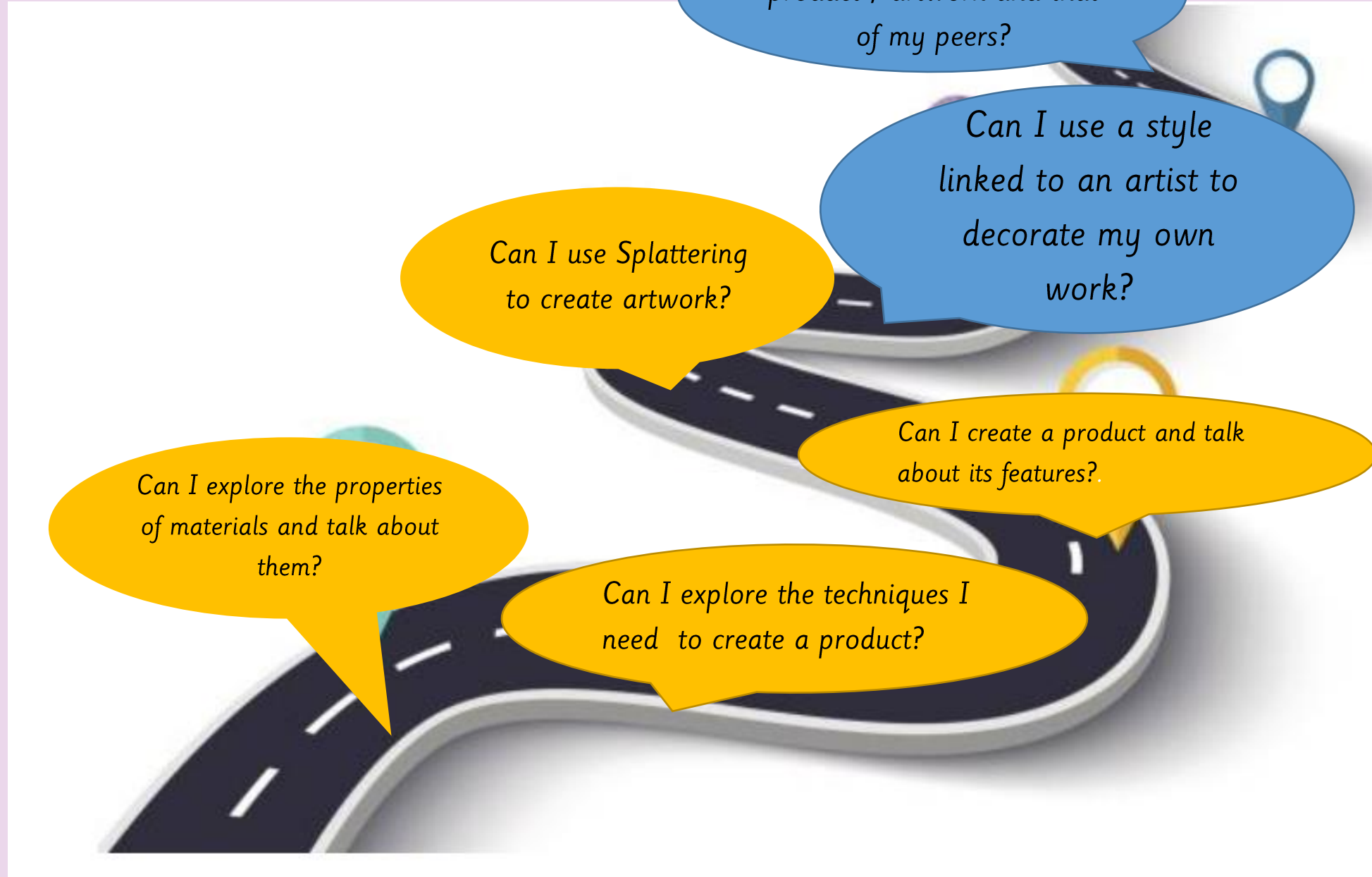

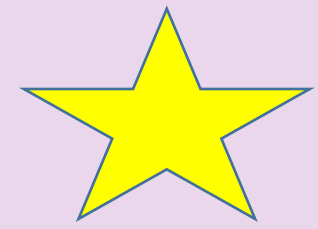

Who is Jackson Pollock?





Jackson Pollock was a famous American painter known for his unique 'drip technique'. He created the splatter patterns by pouring or splashing paint onto a canvas laid flat on the floor.
