Definition: the marks used in writing to separate sentences (full stop, capital letter, question mark, exclamation mark).

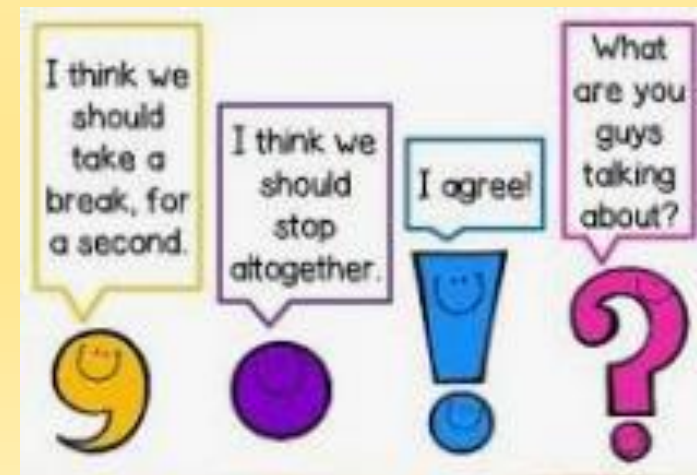

They are words that we use in Year 1 in our *reading* and our *writing*.

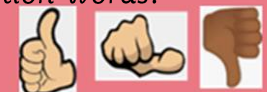
We need to recognise these words throughout Year 1 and practice.
