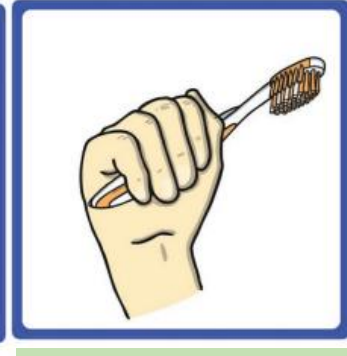
Chronological means to put something in the order that has happened. Which one of these is in chronological order and which one is not? How do you know?

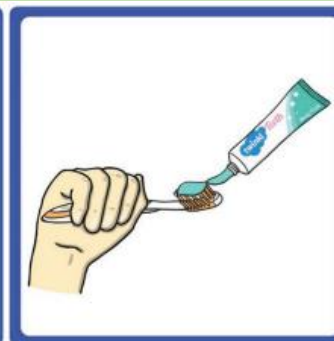

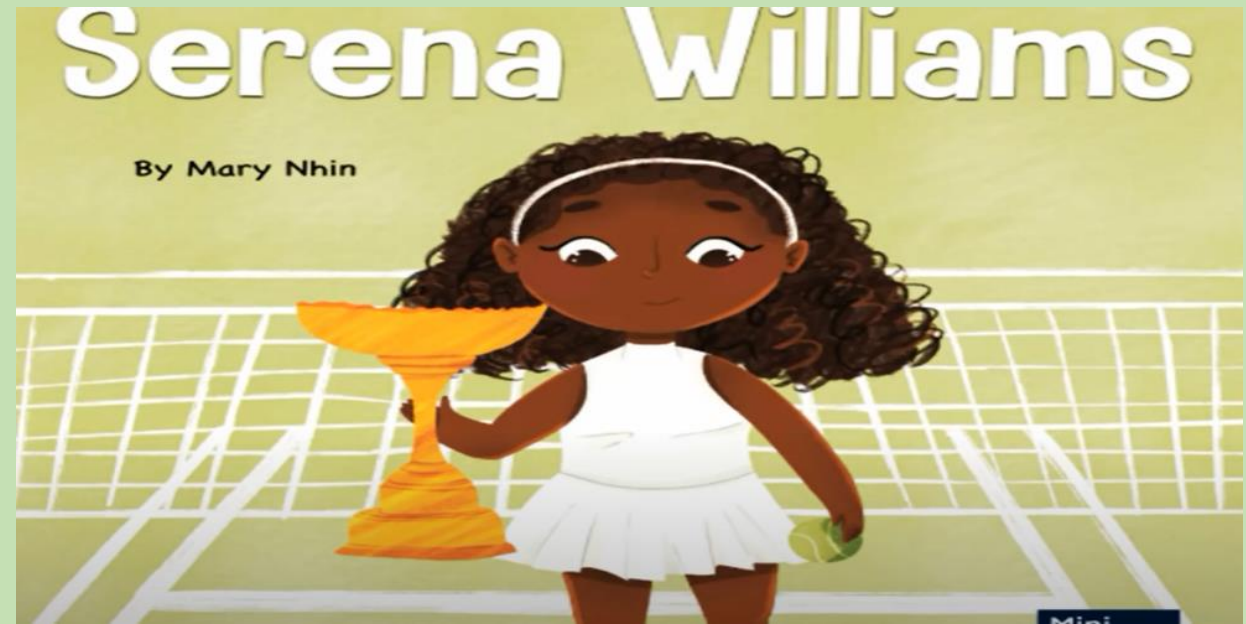

She wrote a journal when people were unkind to her. The journal made her happy.

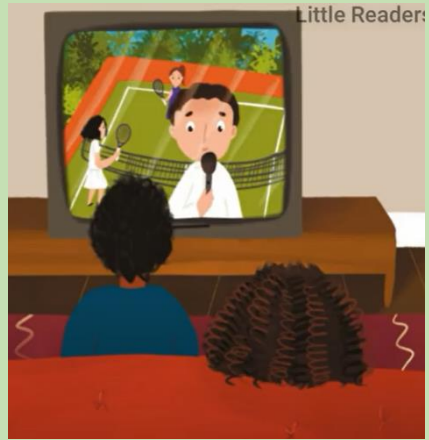
