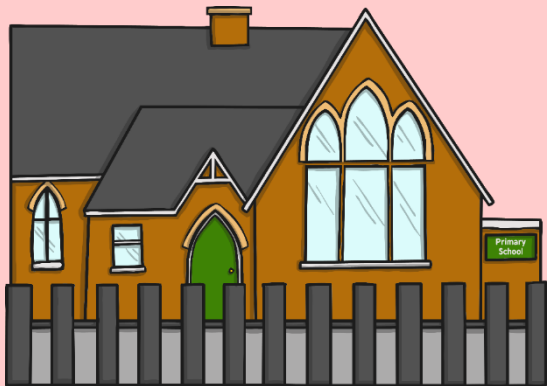
What does it mean to be thankful?

*This half term we will think about saying thank you; we will observe some of the ways we can approach puzzling ideas.*





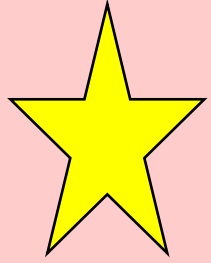

# God as creator of the world

- Many religions believe that God created the world.
- Jews, Christians and Muslims all believe that God (Allah) created the world in 6 days.
- Most religions believe it is their responsibility to care for the world God created.
- That is why many religious people consider it their duty to care for the environment.



# The Creation Story:

*Day 1: God made light.*

*Day 2: God separated the heavens and the earth.*

*Day 3: God made the seas, dry land, plants and trees.*

*Day 4: God made the sun, moon and stars.*

*Day 5: God made creatures that fly and live in the sea.*

*Day 6: God made animals and peoples*

*Day 7: God rested.*

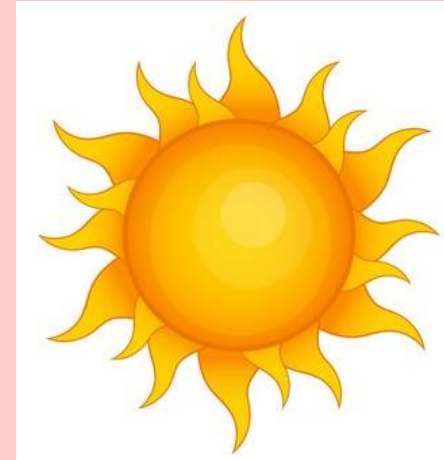
