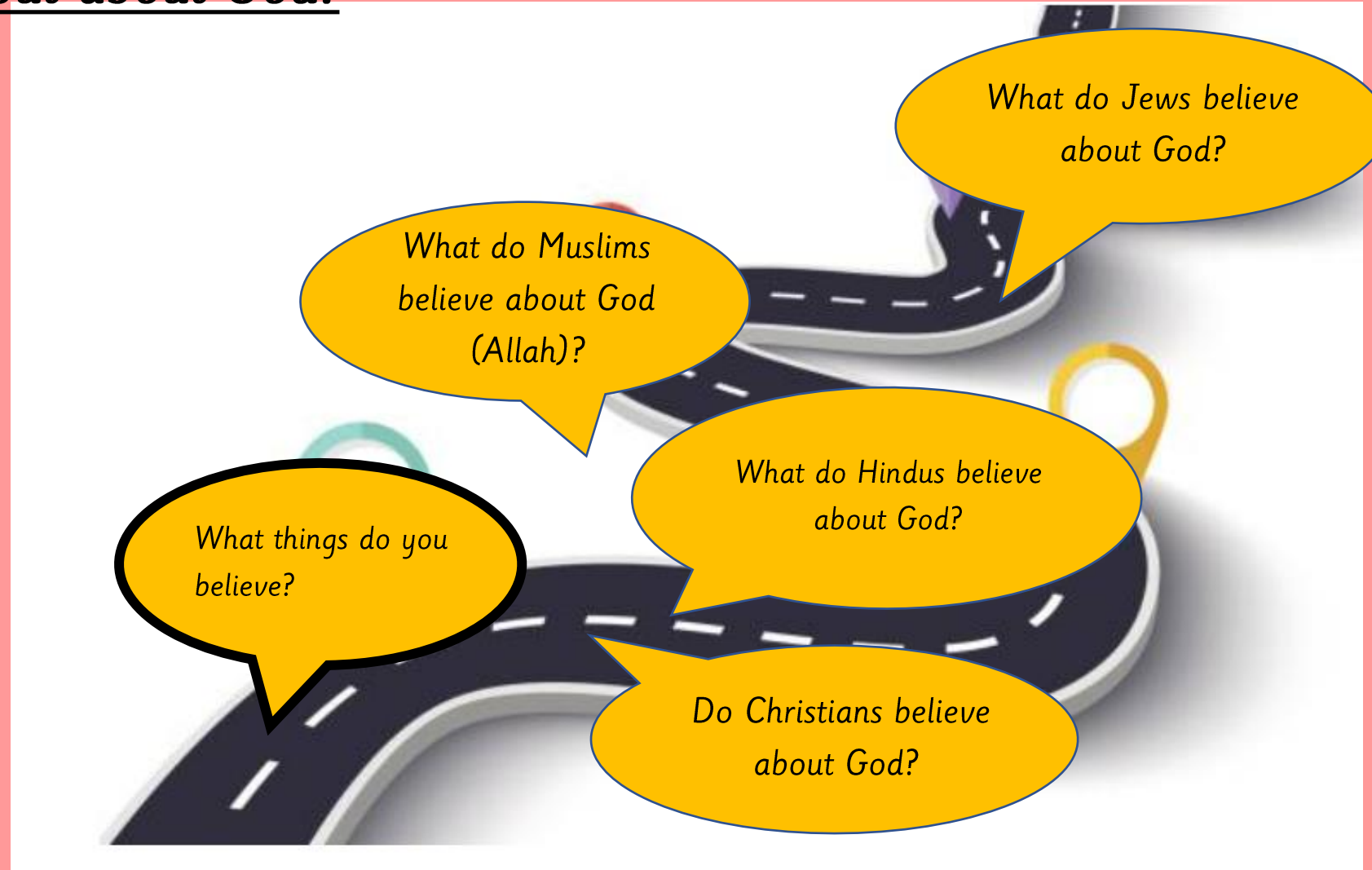

Jewish people believe in the importance of following God's **commandments** (laws/rules) and studying the **Torah**.



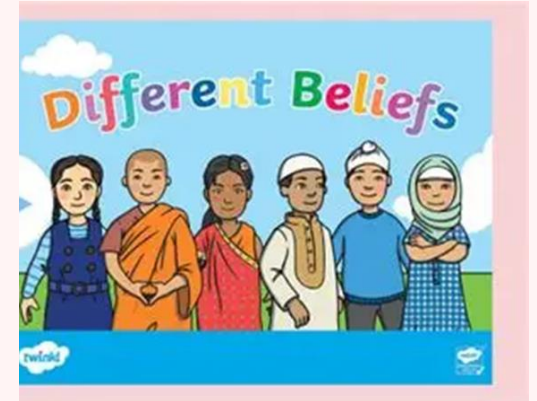
